On Tuesday 21st September 2010 TECNIA INSTITUTE OF ADVANCED STUDIES gave opportunity to its 1st semester BJ(MC) students to visit DAINIK JAGRAN's printing press. The Dainik Jagran's printing press is situated in Noida(sector 63).

Overall approximately 90 students were accompanied by 3 faculty members, Dr.S.P.Dahiya Mr. Umesh C.Pathak &.Ms Sapna. Students reached there around 1:30p.m for convenience the students were divided into 3 grups of 30 each for a tour inside the building with one group going inside at a time.

The building within was divided into 6 halls with approximately 2-2.5 lakhs newspaper output from each daily. The halls were fully installed with huge n enormous machines worth more than 4 – 5 crores. The machines were all well equipped, updated and advanced. Stuents learned many new things as the process of how papers are printed, how color is drawn on them, how the words are imposed on the paper and finally how all the process is carried out and by whom.

Our students learnt that newspapers are basically made up of 4 colours - CYAN, MAGENTA, YELLOW & BLACK. These colours are put up on minute pixels of the newspapers via plates of each colour.

They even got a chance to interact with the workers over there. All this wsa showed up around by the head of the production department, MR.ARUN KUMAR SINGH and Mr.D S Bisht.He delivered a special lecture and told us all the technical terms and keywords. Then, there was a short question answer session where he cleared all doubts of students regarding printing. The overall learning experience was very interesting and fun. All the students were then provided with the refreshments and the visit to DAINIK JAGRAN's printing press came to an end with it. \odot
