TV media is now deviating from the responsibility to the society and the seriousness of contents and issues what are debating on primetime in contrast with advertisements abruptly interrupting the serious talks or debates. He emphasized on a need of serious research study in India about the impact of media on the population other than the marketing aspects.

National Conference on Global Trends and Issues in Media Communication

Prof. Rajesh Bajaj, Chief Convener, TIAS, deliberated on changing communication technologies in the media industry. For traditional communication technology, he gave an example of selection procedure of 'Pope'. He pointed out on changing of presentation pattern in the media communication.
