He has interviewd almost all Bollywood stars including Yash Chopra, Amitabh Bachchan, Asha Bhonsle Shahrukh Khan, Aamir Khan, Asihwarya Rai, Akshay Kuma, Nashirudiin Shah, Om Puri etc. He also interview of Sachin Tendulkar, Rahul Dravid, Virender Sehwag, Gautam Gambhir Yuvraj Singh, Dutee Chand, Hima Das, Bajrang Punia, Sushil Kumar etc.

## Report:

A workshop was organized for BA(J&MC) final year students on Friday, 27<sup>th</sup> August, 2019 under the ambit of Capability Enhancement Scheme to make students understand the scope and opportunity as Film Journalist. The Speaker Mr. Amit Anand discussed that in

order to developed a career in Film journalism, one needs to be strong in communication both written and verbal, should have a keen interest in movies, should read reviews a lot, should be analytical and a deep cinema sense. He also described the difference between documentary, feature film and series (serials & Web series). While discussing the Hollywood movies, he emphasized that the use of technology has made huge impact on casting, screening and production.
