Celebration of World Hindi Diwas

World Hindi Diwas is celebrated on 10th January every year. The day commemorates the anniversary of the first World Hindi Conference held in Nagpur of January 10, 1975. The aim of the conference was to promote Hindi language worldwide. It was first celebrated in 2006 by former Prime Minister Dr. Manmohan Singh with an aim to promote Hindi language across the world.

The staff and students of Tecnia Institute of Advanced Studies celebrated World Hindi Diwas on 10th January, 2020 in the Campus as a mark of acknowledgement of HINDI as the National Language.

The celebrations began with the Invocation Poetry on Hindi by a student of TIAS. Followed by the interaction with the students by Dr.Ajay Kumar Singh, Faculty of BA (J&MC) department. He Spoke on the occasion and tried to spread the message "Hindi hamaari shaan hai; desh ka abhimaan hai."
