

Pranab becomes the first Bengali President



ranab Mukherjee on 25th July took oath as the 13th President of India. "I will strive to preserve, protect and defend our Constitution," Pranab Mukherjee said after taking oath as the President. Veteran Congress leader defeated his rival PA Sangma to get elected as the 13th President of India.

Pranab won the election with 69.31 per cent votes. A total of 713,937 votes were in favour of Pranab out of the total 10,29,924 votes, while his opponent Sangma had 315,987 votes or 30.69 per cent of the total

Prime Minister Dr. Manmohan Singh,

Congress President Sonia Gandhi, Lok Sabha Speaker Meira Kumar and all Senior Cabinet Ministers, Congress leaders and leaders from UPA allies and NDA met Pranab Mukheriee to congratulate him. Pranab became the first Bengali to occupy either of the highest offices - PM, President or Vice President.

76-year-old Mukherjee was administered the oath of office to "preserve, protect and defend the constitution and law" by Chief Justice of India Sarosh Homi Kapadia at an impressive ceremony in the historic Central Hall of Parliament.

Just after he took oath, he was offered a 21gun salute marking the assumption of office of the highest constitutional post in the

In his brief acceptance address, he said the principal responsibility of this office is to function as the guardian of the Constitution.

"I will strive to preserve, protect and defend the Constitution not just in words but in spirit," Mukherjee said.

He also said word poverty should be eliminated from the dictionary of modern India but felt tickle down theory would not work. He said hunger i s humiliation for the mankind. Referring to the change of equations post-Cold War, he said the world was in the midst of

War fighting terror of which India had the early experience.

Mukherjee ended his speech saying "there can be no greater reward for a public servant than becoming the First Citizen of the country."

Before the function in Parliament, the outgoing President and the President-elect, wearing a black achkan, churidar (long coat, pyjama), drove a small distance in the bullet-proof presidential limousine from the North Court to the forecourt of Rashtrapati Bhavan.





विशेषिका में शॉपिंग मॉल्स को 60 वर्ष पूरे हो गए हैं। लेकिन अब इनका क्रेज घटता जा रहा है। 1500 से ज्यादा मॉल या तो दम तोड़ चुके हैं या फिर बंद होने की कागार पर हैं। अब उनकी जगह ऑफिस बना दिए गए हैं या बनाए जा रहे हैं। 'द अटलांटिक' पत्रिका के अनुसार, अमेरिका में पहला मॉल 1952 में बना था। वर्ष 2000 तक

और अब आलम यह है कि 2006 के बाद से अमेरिका में कोई भी नया मॉल नहीं खुला है। बल्कि कई बंद हो चुके हैं या फिर बंद होने वाले हैं।

वर्ष 2010 में ओहियो में एक मॉल को ध्वस्त कर पार्क बना दिया गया। न्यूजर्सी में भी आधे मॉल तोड़ दिये गए हैं। भारत में मॉल अभी जवानी की अंगड़ाई ले रहा है लेकिन जवानी में कई मॉल बंद होने की कागार पर हैं। वर्ष 1999 में दिल्ली और मुंबई में मॉल अस्तित्व में आए थे लेकिन यहां भी 80 फीसदी मॉल लड़खड़ाने लगे हैं।

यह हाल केवल अमेरिका में ही नहीं वरन् पूरे विश्व का है।



August 2, 1776 - In Philadelphia, most of the 55 members of the Continental Congress signed the parchment copy of the Declaration of Independence.

August 16, 1777 - During the American Revolutionary War, the Battle of Bennington, Vermont, occurred as militiamen from Vermont, aided by Massachusetts troops, wiped out a detachment of 800 German-Hessians sent by British General Burgoyne to seize horses.


August 16, 1780 - The Battle of Camden in South Carolina occurred during the American Revolutionary War. The battle was a big defeat for the Americans as forces under General Gates were defeated by troops of British General Charles Cornwallis, resulting in 900 Americans killed and 1,000 captured.

August 31, 1786 - Shays' Rebellion began in Massachusetts as ex-Revolutionary War Captain Daniel Shays led an armed mob. The rebellion prevented the Northampton Court from holding a session in which debtors, mostly poor ex-soldier farmers, were to be tried and likely put in prison. Following this, in September, Shays' troops prevented Supreme Court sessions at Springfield, Massachusetts. Early in 1787, they attacked the Federal arsenal at Springfield, but were soon routed and fled. Shays was sentenced to death but was pardoned in 1788.

Photo credit: A photographer's byline. The name of the person or organization responsible for making or distributing a photograph, usually appearing small type under the reproduced picture. Also called credit line.

Pica: (1) 12-point type; (2) Unit of linear measurement equal to 1/6 of an inch (i.e., six picas = one inch.).

Plagiarism: Passing off as one's own the ideas and words of another.

Plate: A plate contains the image of several pages, in multiples of 4, and is installed onto the press.

Pre-date: An edition issued before its announced date of publication.

Press: Machine that prints the newspaper.

Press Run: Total number of copies printed.

Proof: A page on which newly set copy is reproduced to make possible the correction of errors.

If we think every individual, every member equal in all aspects whether it is belongingness, education, caring, loving and security provided to special children.


