# Faculty Development Program in Tecnia



**A** Faculty Entrepreneurship Development Program was conducted by National Foundation of Indian Engineers and Tecnia Institute of Advanced Studies. The program was sponsored by Government of India, Ministry of Science and Technology, Department of Science and Technology, National Science and Technology Entrepreneurship Development Board (NSTEDB). This program commenced from 26th Dec 2011 to 7th Jan 2012.

The objective of this program is to train faculty members in Entrepreneurial traits so that they can act as resource persons in guiding and motivating young professionals to be entrepreneurs of tomorrow.

## 1st Day - 26 Dec 2011

**Session 1:** All the faculty members registered themselves for the FDP sessions. Chairman R.K. Gupta felicitated the Chief guest Dr. H. K. Mittal, advisor and head NSTEDB. The Chief guest Dr. H. K. Mittal, advisor and head NSTEDB, and Mr. R. K. Gupta, chairman, Tecnia Group Inaugurated the program. Dr. Ajay Rathore, Director, TIAS, gave the welcome address and introduced the TECNIA Group. Dr. Nirmal Singh told the importance and necessity of Faculty Development Program. Dr. P. K. Gupta, Secretary General NAFEN said that entrepreneurship is today's necessity. He gave the example of TECNIA for entrepreneurship how Mr. Gupta developed Tecnia in last 14 years. Mr. R. K. Gupta, chairman, Tecnia Group, gave thanks to the Ministry for sponsoring FDP. Dr. H. K. Mittal, advisor and head, NSTEDB discussed the different aspects of entrepreneurship and business. Dr. Sandeep Kumar gave the vote of thanks.

**Session 2:** Dr. P. K. Gupta discussed the evolution of management, difference between goal and objectives, and the history, latest trend of management. He further gave an introduction to entrepreneurship, the quality of successful entrepreneur and the draw-backs of entrepreneurship along with myths and realities.

## 2nd Day - 27 Dec 2011

Prof. S. Dasgupta described the management of change in emerging organizations, nature & factors of organizational change, process of planned change. He continued with explaining different factors of organizational change, effects of change and function of change, management by objective. He stressed on the advantages and disadvantages.

## 3rd Day - 28 Dec 2011

Prof. P. N. Kathuria communicated the skills and stress management techniques of communication. He stressed on listening in communicating and gave some tips to improve this power. He told dis-stress as bad stress and eu-stress as good stress. He told about BOSS-burn out stress syndrome and ROSS-rust out stress syndrome. He explained to cope up with stress by giving interesting examples. He also stressed on Yoga and taught the participants how to meditate.

## 4th Day - 29 Dec 2011

Mr. Neeraj Sharma addressed on the role of entrepreneurship development program. He explained training as a tool and how to select a potential entrepreneur.

In the second session Dr. V. K. Mathur stressed on personality development. While giving stress on temperament and character he told some characteristics of a good personality, the importance of positive

attitude by giving example of some important personality. He told the rules of body language in personality.

## 5th Day - 30 Dec 2011

Dr. Archana Singh discussed financial management. She stated the basic tools of financial management as time value of money, risk and return and valuation. She explained the financial plan of start-up. The essential things in financial management as income statement, balance Sheet and cash flow statement.

## 6th Day - 31 Dec 2011

Dr. V. K. Mathur stressed on leadership qualities. He told some leadership trades and its different types. He discussed the theories of leadership trait, behavioral, contingency and transactional theory. He discussed HR strategies for new entrepreneurs and gave some guidelines and told how motivation impacts on developmental plans. He also told about some acts on employee termination.

## 7th Day - 02 Jan 2012

Mr. Ashwani Gupta focused on Technology & Innovation management, and new product development for MSMEs in India. He told about some sectors of micro, small and medium entrepreneurs and opportunities and threats associated with them. Some project profiles were presented for MSMEs on which a new entrepreneur can develop. In the second half Prof. S. Dasgupta addressed Time Management, objectivities, styles and skills of time management. He stressed on time management, planning and scheduling, doing and acting and finishing for which motivation is required.

## 8th Day - 03 Jan 2012

Dr. P. N. Kathuria focused on problem solving and decision making. He told on its



approaches and the techniques of problem solving and decision making. He informed about different styles of decision making. He discussed the meaning, characteristics and theory of motivation and focused on Mc. Leland achievement theory. According to him achievement motivation is very important for success of an entrepreneur.

**9th Day - 04 Jan 2012**

Dr. P. N. Kathuria addressed the group

dynamics and behavior. He told why people join any group, how to develop groups. He gave some interesting information about group effects. He explained social lobbying, social felicitation and group thinking. He told about ISO-9001 quality management, various standards of ISO & various versions of ISO. He stressed that documentations is a stringent requirement of ISO-9001.

**10th Day - 05 Jan 2012**

Dr. Archana Singh discussed Working Capital Management. She discussed case studies of Dells Working Capital, Flipcart.com Capital, Khasi Arts Shilong & Tata Motors

**11th Day - 06 Jan 2012**

Dr David Wittenberg told the purpose of education and focused on different learning styles, teaching tools. He compared teaching methods between India and USA with some group learning and individual learning activities. He focused on child centered methods of teaching for achieving the goal of learning. He also discussed Entrepreneurship and its global impact, how to take your company to the next level, problem solving, management, leadership.

**12th Day - 07 Jan 2012**

On the concluding day of FDP the participants presented their SWOT analysis and shared their experiences with each other. Dr. Then after valedictory address was given by Nirmal Singh. Dr. P. K. Gupta declared this FDP as the best Faculty Development program he attended so far. Chairman Mr. R. K Gupta said the usefulness of this entire program depends on how the faculties develop entrepreneurship skills among their students. Mr. R. K. Gupta, Chairman, Tecnia Group and Dr. P. K. Gupta, Sec. Gen. NAFEN distributed certificates to all the participants.

The Faculty Development Program (FDP) provided inputs on process and practice of entrepreneurship development, communication and inter-personal skills, creativity and problem solving, time management, achievement motivation training, inputs on resource and knowledge industries, stress management and yoga.

The training methodology included case studies, group discussion, games and exercise, classroom lectures etc. overall this program has been very much useful for the participants. The program will be convened by Dr. Ajay Pratap Singh.

**January 15, 69 A.D.** - Roman Emperor Servius Sulpicius Galba was assassinated by the Praetorian guard in the Roman Forum. He had succeeded Emperor Nero.

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**January 1, 1502** - Portuguese explorers landed at Guanabara Bay on the coast of South America and named it Rio de Janeiro (River of January). Rio de Janeiro is currently Brazil's second largest city.

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**January 25, 1533** - King Henry VIII married his second wife, Anne Boleyn, in defiance of Pope Clement who had refused to annul his first marriage. The King later broke all ties with Rome and became Supreme Head of the Church of England.

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**January 15, 1535** - Henry VIII became Supreme Head of the Church in England as a result of the Act of Supremacy following his break with Rome.

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**January 16, 1547** - Ivan the Terrible had himself officially crowned as the first Russian Czar (Caesar) although he had already ruled Russia since 1533. His reign lasted until 1584 and brought much needed reforms including a new legal code and cultural development. However, during his reign he instituted a campaign of terror against the Russian nobility and had over 3,000 persons put to death. He also killed his own son during a fit of rage.
