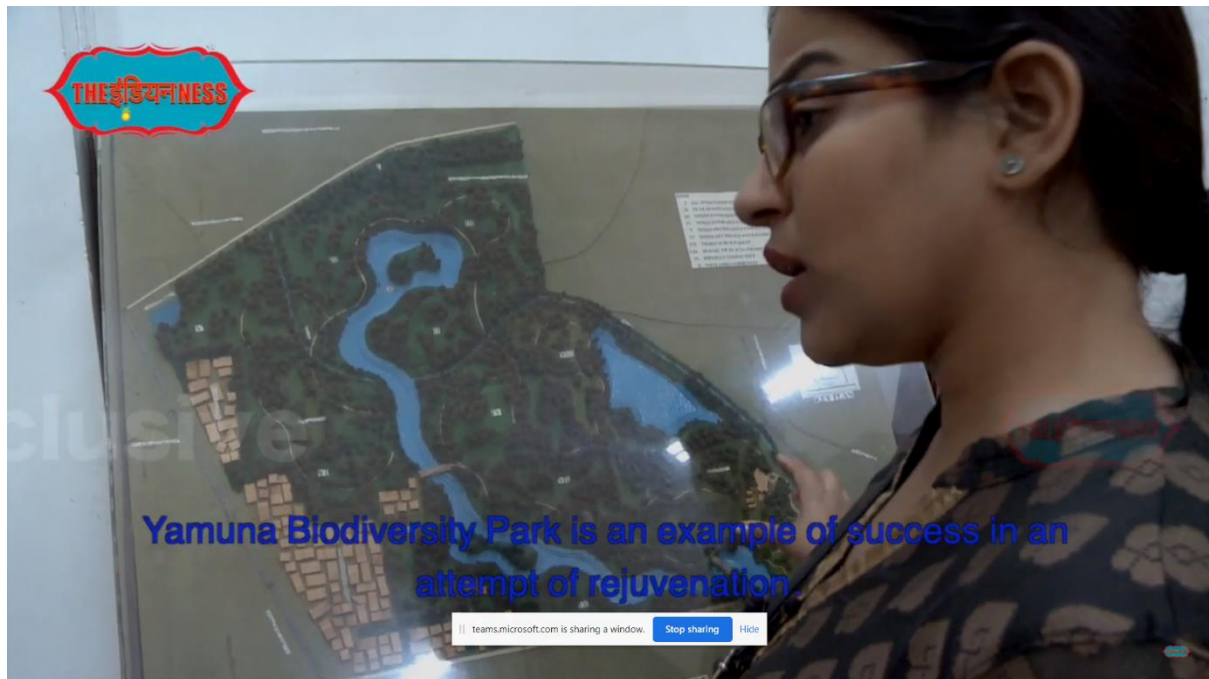

Awareness Campaign on Water Pollution

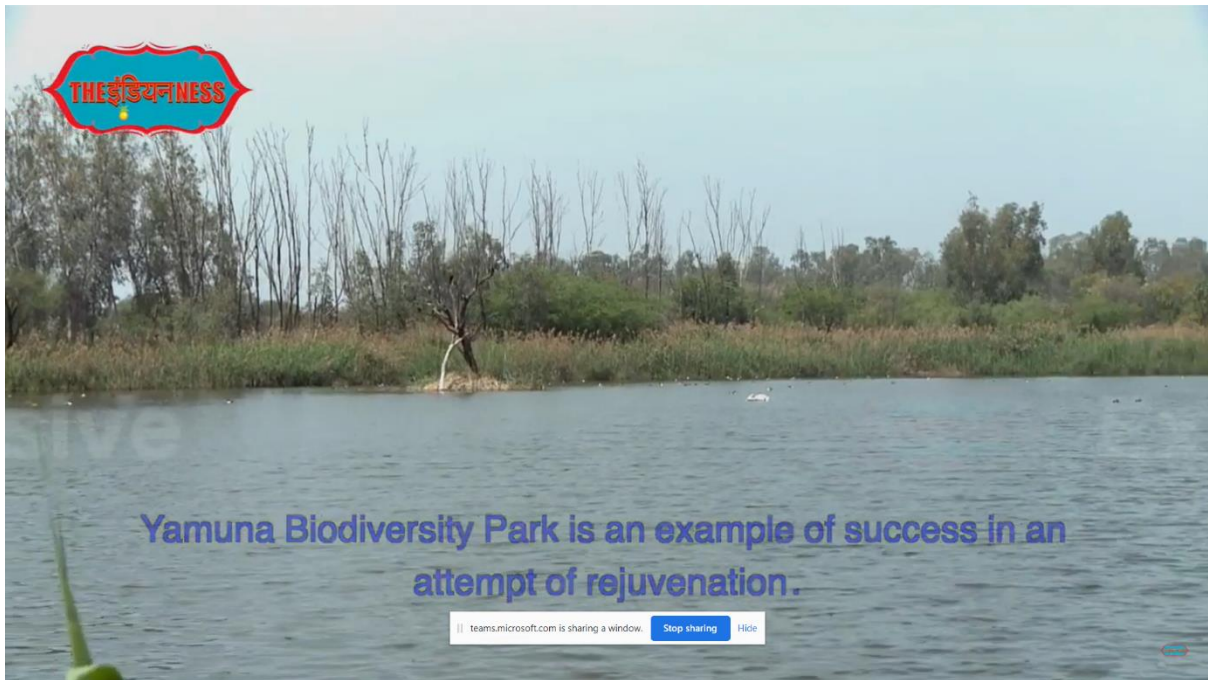
OBJECTIVES OF THE EVENT:

- To optimize management of nutrients and water resources.
- To carry out awareness drive and sensitizing public at large about the ill-effects of immersion in holy water.
- To avoid use of non-toxic and bio-degradable chemical dyes for painting.
- To prevent pollution of surface and ground water.
- To reduce health risk related to sanitation, contaminated water and waste.

REPORT

Awareness Campaign on Water Pollution was organized by Eco Club of Tecnia Institute of Advanced Studies, Rohini, Delhi on 22nd Jan 2021. TIAS propagated Eco Club under the aegis of Department of Environment, Government of NCT of Delhi, has been dispensed accountable for edifying the overall Environmental Quality in Delhi NCR which has also been entrusted with the overall environmental assessment, monitoring, protection and awareness among the people of Delhi; Multi- facets methods is being espoused by the Department for Promotion, Conservation and Preservation of Environment.

Institute's Eco Clubs plays an important role in creating environmental awareness amongst the future generation. India is a rich cultural country in which various festivals are organized. Idol is an image of god and after worship these idols are immersed into water bodies. These idols are made of Plaster of Paris, clay, bamboo, rods and other decorated materials prepared with different paint colours. Paints which are used to colour idols are made of Mercury, Cadmium, Arsenic, Zinc, Chromium and Lead.

The Eco club functions under faculty in charge –Dr. Kirti Miglani, Assistant Professor- BBA, Dr. Sheetal Badesra- Incharge Student Welfare and Dr. Rashmi Gujrati along with a group of volunteers from students to take initiative and campaigns on the environmental issues and to take the appropriate actions to improve the environment.

Eco club volunteers spread the message among students to discourage use of materials and idols made with non-toxic material and idols painted with dyes should be discouraged. Awareness campaign was organized and stakeholders were informed about the harmful effects of nontoxic material. Information was spread among the people that biodegradable waste needs to be collected separately. Public needs to be educated about the ill-effects of idols immersion in the water. Suitable directions were be issued by police officers to take appropriate action against the offenders violating these directions. And penalty needs to be charged of Rs. 5000/- on the ones who are disobeying the directions.

As there are harmful effects of water pollution which can be seen so the initiative needs to be spread about the health effects which may cause cancer and other diseases, skin infections and other harmful health effects on aquatic life.

Learning Outcome:

- Students were encouraged for proper maintenance and preservation of water resources.
- Students were made aware about the use of non-toxic and bio-degradable chemical dyes through spreading message on water pollution.
- Information needs to be spread about the ill-effects of toxic material in water.
