- To evaluate the students' employability skill through interview
- To make students learn how to appear in interview.

Report:

Employability Index Test through interview was organized for BA (JMC) final year students was organised in two rounds. The first round was from 11th May'21 to 14th May 2021, and the final on 22nd May, 2021 by TIAS who are willing to do jobs in different fields as per their ability and choice after completion of their BA (JMC) program. The purpose of organizing the session was to prepare the students for their placements. The evaluation was done on their subject knowledge and

soft skills. The subject knowledge included theoretical knowledge, its practical application and latest development in the relevant area. The soft skills judged were their communication skill, body language, profile fitment, introduction skill and confidence. In the first round, Employability index was evaluated by internal panel members, based on which top five candidates from each section were allowed for a final round of evaluation. For the final round, the panel member consisted of Mr. Paras Mishra, an alumnus of the batch BA(JMC) 2015-17) presently working as Digital News Manager, Zee Media (ZMCL), Mr. Mayak Arora, Assistant Professor, Department of Mass Communication and Dr. Nivedita, Head Training and Placement Cell.


The selection of going through interview for Employability Index was based on the fact that mock interviews would be a practice sessions for the students about the look, sound, and feel of actual interviews. Mock interview provides an opportunity to students actually practicing going through an interview, answering and asking questions, and hopefully learning about the rhythm and possible interview questions they will face in real life.

In the final round Mr. Paras asked relevant questions pertaining to the area of interest of the students, while the soft skills of the students were judged by Mr. Paras along with Dr. Nivedita. Every students was shared the feedback werbally then and there itself. The session was coordinated by Mr. Myayank Arora who also made students comfortable during the process. Later, Mr. Mayank Arora compiled the sheet with the marks and area of improvement

Learning Outcome:


- Students' were evaluated for their employability skills
