
### **CLOSING:**




### **LEARNING OUTCOME:**



## 1. STUDENT PROFILE:







### 2. STUDENT FEEDBACK ON WORKSHOP




Chart-4 depicts the workshop platform comfortable of student respondents. It was noticed that, total 65 responses were collected from the students and 100% students were completely satisfied.














