

Information about Scholarship/Fellowship Schemes of AICTE - Academic Year 2020-21 - Reg

Sir/Madam,

Greetings from Student Development Cell, AICTE, New Delhi!

It is our pleasure to share with you all that every year, AICTE is providing scholarship support to the students enrolled in the AICTE approved institutions.

For the current academic year, the various scholarship/ fellowship schemes of AICTE are as follows:

1. AICTE - Pragati Scholarship Scheme for Girl Students (Degree and Diploma):-

Number of scholarships under this scheme has been enhanced from 4000 to 10,000 with a fixed number of scholarships for 23 States/ Union Territories.

In addition to 10,000 scholarships, all eligible girl students who submit online application for scholarship from institutions located in the 13 Union Territories and North Eastern States namely Andaman and Nicobar Islands (UT), Jammu and Kashmir (UT), Ladakh (UT), Dadra and Nagar Haveli & Daman and Diu (UT), Lakshadweep (UT), Arunachal Pradesh, Assam, Manipur, Meghalaya, Mizoram, Nagaland, Sikkim & Tripura may be considered for scholarship by AICTE.

Besides this from the academic year 2020-21 onwards, girl students taking admission in the second year of degree/diploma programme through lateral entry are also eligible to apply for scholarships.

2. AICTE - Saksham Scholarship Scheme for Specially Abled Students (Degree and Diploma):-

Under this scheme, all eligible specially abled students taking admission in the first year of degree/ diploma or second year through lateral entry may be considered for scholarship.

NOTE: For academic year 2020-21, online application for the AICTE Pragati & Saksham scholarship schemes will be invited through National Scholarship Portal (NSP) (https://scholarships.gov.in/) of Government of India which will be tentatively opened on 15th August 2020 for online applications.

3. AICTE Doctoral Fellowship (ADF):-

Existing National Doctoral Fellowship (NDF) scheme has been changed to AICTE Doctoral Fellowship (ADF) with a fixed number of fellowships assigned to the respective Technical Universities. Now onward, research scholars will be directly admitted by respective Technical Universities.

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GUIDELINES FOR AICTE Doctoral Fellowship (ADF) 2020-21



AICTE DOCTORAL FELLOWSHIP (ADF)

1.0 OBJECTIVES: -

The objectives of the ADF scheme are:

- ➤ To promote research culture in AICTE approved Institutions.
- To promote collaborative research between Institute and Industries leading to start-ups.
- > To nurture talents for technical research.

2.0 BRAOD THRUST AREAS FOR THE RESEARCH: -

Some of the broad thrust areas (but not limited) for the research are as follows:-

- ➤ Green Technologies
- ➤ Big Data, Machine Learning & Data Sciences
- ➤ Block Chain
- > Artificial Intelligence
- > Energy Production and Storage
- ➤ Electronics & Photonics
- ➤ Nuclear Engineering and Allied Technologies
- Robotics and Mechatronics
- ➤ Augmented Reality (AR)/ Virtual Reality (VR)
- > Energy Efficiency, Renewable and sustainable Energy
- ➤ Electric and Hybrid Mobility
- > Smart Cities, Housing and Transportation
- ➤ Internet of Things (IoT)
- > 3D Printing
- Quantum Computing
- Smart Technologies for Agriculture and Food Industry
- > Water purification, conservation and management
- Public Policy
- Social & Organizational Psychology & Behaviour
- > Cyber Security

3.0 ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR THE AWARD OF FELLOWSHIP: -

The detailed criteria for the award of fellowship are as follows:

a) The fellowship/HRA/contingency will be granted to research scholars admitted in the Technical Universities in the identified thrust areas of the ADF scheme.

- **b)** Technical Universities will admit candidates in their research programme as per their procedure following minimum eligibility criteria as prescribed by AICTE.
- c) The candidate must have secured minimum cumulative grade point average (CGPA) of 7.5 on the scale of 10 (or minimum 75% marks) or equivalent at both Bachelors and Masters. In addition to above, the candidate should have qualified GATE/GPAT/NET during the last 5 years. For SC/ST/PH candidates, CGPA requirement will be 7.0 on the scale of 10 (or 70% marks) or equivalent.
- **d)** The candidate should be less than 30 years of age as on date of admission in respective Technical University. However, age relaxation of 5 years would be applicable to candidates belonging to SC/ST, women and physically challenged category in succession.

4.0 DURATION OF THE SCHEME: -

The duration of the scheme shall be for a period of 3 Years. Further one-year extension (In two slots of 6 months' each) may be given by AICTE on the recommendation of the respective Technical University based upon the performance of the scholar in the research work.

5.0 AMOUNT OF FELLOWSHIP: -

The Fellowship will be Rs. 31,000/- pm for the first two years followed by Rs. 35,000/- pm for the third year. HRA will be provided at the rate of 8%, 16% and 24% as per the Government of India (GoI) norms as applicable in the city/ location where the Research Fellow is pursuing their research and are not provided any hostel accommodation in the institute.

In addition, Contingency grant will be admissible to the Scholars at the rate of Rs.15, 000/- per annum to meet the miscellaneous expenditures.

6.0 NUMBER OF FELLOWSHIP: -

Maximum of 300 Nos. of fellowship may be granted in a year. Number of candidates per technical university would be between 5-18, subject to the availability of seats in the research Centre and demand of a research Centre by candidates. The Technical University wise number of seats is enclosed in **Annexure A.**

7.0 ROLE AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE TECHNICAL UNIVERSITIES: -

- a) Technical University will assign one faculty as Nodal Officer for the scheme who will act as an interface between the technical university and AICTE on various operational aspects of the scheme.
- b) Technical University will select candidates for the fellowship as per laid down criteria.
- c) Technical University will update joining report of the scholar on the online portal of AICTE along with bank accounts details and subsequently monthly attendance of the enrolled scholars through online portal for the disbursement of the fellowship directly in the scholar's account.

- **d**) Technical University will ensure that scholar must be registered in the PhD programme within one year of start of fellowship after completion of mandatory course work etc. falling which fellowship will be discontinued.
- **e**) Annual progress report of the enrolled scholar will be submitted Online to AICTE for the monitoring purpose.

8.0 CANCELLATION OF AWARD: -

The fellowship is liable to cancellation in case of:

- a) Registration in Ph.D. not within one year from date of joining.
- **b)** Misconduct.
- c) Unsatisfactory progress of research work/ failure in any examination related to Ph.D.
- **d**) He/ She is found ineligible later.
- **e)** Any false information furnished by the applicant or any fraudulent activity by the Scholar/ Fellow/ Research Awardees shall lead to Penal action against him/ her.
- **f**) The fellowship may be terminated at any time during the tenure and the decision of the AICTE will be final and binding.

9.0 TERMS AND CONDITIONS: -

- a) Registration for Ph.D. is mandatory within one year from the date of joining as a research fellow. If candidate has not registered himself/ herself within one year from date of joining, then fellowship will be discontinued upto his/ her registration for Ph.D.
- **b)** In the cases where the fellowship has been discontinued as per clause (a) above, the fellowship may be resumed after the registration in Ph.D. However, the maximum tenure of fellowship in such cases will be limited to as mentioned in clause 4.0 above.
- c) The awardees shall submit an annual report on the progress, each year through the Research Supervisor, Head of the Department and Head of the Institute to AICTE.
- **d**) The final progress report should be submitted by the awardees through the Head of the Department / Institution to the AICTE.
- e) The awardees shall not be allowed for transfer of award from the Institution where the awardees are presently working for Ph.D. during the entire tenure of the award.
- f) The awardees shall devote full time to research during the tenure of fellowship and will not be permitted to take any part time/ full time assignment. He/ She will not accept any salary, fellowship or any type of financial assistance offered during the tenure of fellowship through any other source otherwise the entire amount of fellowship will have to be refunded. The nature of the candidature (Full time AICTE sponsored Doctoral Fellow) will not be changed during the program.
- **g)** The awardees shall give a declaration that if the results of research are such that can be exploited commercially by taking a patent or otherwise, commercial exploitation and patent rights should be with the Institute, candidate and supervisor. However, the rules of respective research institute, if any, in this regards will be applicable.
- **h)** AICTE online portal will have mechanism for the purpose of releasing fellowship/ HRA/ contingency etc. amount directly in the bank account of the beneficiary through DBT.

- i) The service conditions as notified by Department of Higher Education, Ministry of Human Resource Development vide F. Number 15-2/2019-TC dated 16.07.2019 shall be applicable to awardees.
- **j**) If the progress of the candidate is not satisfactory as reported by the supervisor/ Head of the Department /Head of the Research Institute/ University, the fellowship of the candidature will be terminated with immediate effect. This will not be revoked under any circumstances.
- **k**) The Ph.D. rules/ regulations of the research institute and affiliating University will be applicable to all admitted candidates under this scheme.
- 1) No separate/ fixed medical assistance is provided. However, the fellow may avail of the medical facilities available in the Institution/ University/ College.

m) Leave:-

- (i) Fellows are entitled for a maximum period of (i) 15 days Casual Leave (CL) and (ii) 30 days Medical Leave (ML) in a year in addition to public holidays. They are not entitled to any other vacations.
- (ii) Candidates are eligible for maternity/ Paternity leave as per GoI norms issued from time to time at full rates of fellowship etc. once during the tenure of their award. However, maximum duration of fellowship will not be extended under any circumstances.

Note: All kinds of leave should be approved at the level of the University/ College/ Institute. Prior approval of the University/ Institution/ College is mandatory for all types of leaves.

n) Teaching Assistance (Work Load)

Teaching assistantship of **not more than 8** hours/ week may be given to scholars undergoing full time Ph.D. program under AICTEADF scheme and may include assistance in lab classes, tutorial support etc.

o) Action to be taken in case of leaving the course before completion

The awardees shall furnish an undertaking that in case of his/ her vacating the seat within the duration for which he/ she has been offered fellowship, he/ she shall be liable to refund the entire amount fellowship received by him/ her till the date of his/ her leaving the scheme.

- **p**) The fellow shall not undertake any paid assignment during the tenure of the fellowship (Except in case of leave without fellowship upto one academic year during the entire tenure).
- **q**) This scheme will supersede the currently executed NDF scheme on implementation.

GUIDELINES FOR AICTE – PRAGATI SCHOLARSHIP SCHEME FOR GIRL STUDENTS

(DEGREE & DIPLOMA)

1.0 OBJECTIVES OF THE SCHEME:

Scheme being implemented by AICTE aimed at providing assistance for Advancement of Girls pursuing Technical Education. Education is one of the most important means of empowering women with the knowledge, skill and self-confidence necessary to participate fully in the development process. This is an attempt to give young Women the opportunity to further her education and prepare for a successful future by "Empowering Women through Technical Education"

2.0 ELIGIBILITY FOR SCHOLARSHIPS:

- 1) The girl candidate should be admitted to first year of Degree/Diploma level course OR Second year of Degree/Diploma course through lateral entry in any of the AICTE approved Institution of respective year.
- 2) Maximum two Girls Child per family are eligible.
- 3) Family income from all sources is not more than Rs. 8 lakh per annum during the current financial year. A valid income certificate issued by State/UT Government need to be enclosed.

3.0 NUMBER OF SCHOLARSHIPS:

- 1) A total of 10000 scholarships (5000 each for Degree and Diploma) are earmarked per annum under this scheme for pursuing first year of Degree/Diploma level course OR Second year of Degree/Diploma course through lateral entry in any of the AICTE approved Institutions. The number of scholarships are transferred into each other category (Diploma/Degree) if sufficient number of online applications are not received under one category.
- 2) State/Union Territory wise distribution of 10,000 scholarships for degree and diploma courses is as per Annexure A and B.
- 3) In addition to 10,000 scholarships at point number 2, all eligible girls who submit online scholarship form, from following 13 Union Territories and North Eastern States i.e. Andaman and Nicobar Islands (UT), Jammu and Kashmir (UT), Laddakh (UT), Dadra and Nagar Haveli & Daman and Diu (UT), Lakshadweep (UT), Arunachal Pradesh, Assam, Manipur, Meghalaya, Mizoram, Nagaland, Sikkim & Tripura will be given scholarships by AICTE.

4.0 AMOUNT OF SCHOLARSHIP:

- 1) Rs 50,000 per annum for every year of study i.e. maximum 4 years for Degree and 3 years for Diploma for first year admitted students and maximum 3 years for Degree and 2 years for Diploma for second year admitted students through lateral entry as lump sum amount towards payment of college fee, computer purchase, stationery, books, Equipment, Software's purchase etc. No other additional grant will be payable in lieu of hostel charges and medical charges etc.
- 2) No documentary proof need to be attached for the above while availing benefits.

5.0 MODE OF PAYMENT:

After selection, the awardee will be paid scholarship through DBT mode on annual basis.

6.0 PROCEDURE FOR APPLYING:

- 1) The candidate fulfilling the eligibility conditions is required to apply online on National Scholarship Portal (NSP) after initiation of application process and notice to be published on AICTE website.
- 2) The host institution where the candidate is studying is required to verify the online application.
- 3) Department of Technical Education (DTE) of respective State/ UT will verify these applications as second level of scrutiny.

7.0 CRITERION FOR SELECTION:

- 1) The selection of candidate will be carried out solely on the basis of merit of qualifying examination to peruse the Technical Degree/ Diploma courses from any of the AICTE approved institutions. i.e. In case of Degree (First & Second year) it is on the basis of percentage of marks obtained in the 10+2 examinations and for Diploma (First & Second year) it is on the basis of percentage of marks obtained in 10th examinations.
- 2) State/ UT wise merit list will be prepared as per number of scholarships allotted in the point number 3.0 above.

8.0 METHODS OF RESOLVING TIES:

The procedure to be adopted for breaking ties (similar percentiles) shall be as under: -

A. For Degree Course admitted Students:

- 1) **Percentage of Marks in 10th Examination:** In case 10+2 examination percentile does not break ties, then, higher percentage of marks in 10th examination will be ranked higher.
- **2**) **Age**: In case 10th exam percentile does not break ties, then, Elder age of candidates will be ranked higher.

B. For Diploma Course admitted Students:

1) Age: In case 10th exam percentile does not break ties, then, Elder age of candidates will be ranked higher.

2) **Annual family income:** If above method do not break ties, and then the lower annual family income will settle on in higher ranking for the Scholarships.

9. RESERVATION:

- 1) As per Government of India norms.
- 2) If there is any vacant seat in any of the reserved category (SC/ST/OBC), the same will be transferred to the general category.

10.0 RENEWALS

- 1) The scholarship will be renewed for the next year of study on receipt of renewal through National Scholarship Portal by submitting passing certificate/ marksheet along with letter from the Head of Institution in the online portal.
- 2) Student failing to get promoted to the next class/ level would forfeit the scholarship.

11.0 TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 1) Applications will be invited once in a year through National e-Scholarship Portal of the Government of India.
- 2) If a student is in reserved category and also qualified in general category merit list of scholarship then he/she will be counted under the General Category.
- 3) Incomplete applications will be summarily rejected. Only verified online applications will be considered for the award of scholarship.
- 4) If a candidate failed/ drop out in subsequent year, she will not be eligible for further scholarship.
- 5) Scheme will be implemented and monitored by the AICTE.
- 6) For converting CGPA (Cumulative Grade Point Average) to percentage, multiplying factor will be 9.5 i.e. to convert the CGPA into percentage, CGPA X 9.5 will give the percentage.
- 7) In case both CGPA & Total marks are given in the mark sheet, total marks will be considered for determining percentage.
- 8) If grades are given like A1, A2, B1, B2 etc in the mark sheet, first the grades will be converted into CGPA and then average CGPA will be calculated. This CGPA will be converted into percentage as given in point No. 2.
- 9) Provisional list of shortlisted candidates will be uploaded on the AICTE web portal. In case, candidate has any query about merit list of scholarship, they may raise their grievances within a month. No query regarding merit list will be entertained after one-month duration.
- 10) Query regarding non-payment of the scholarship due to invalid/wrong account number will be entertained only upto six months from the date of publishing of merit list on AICTE website.

GUIDELINES FOR AICTE - SAKSHAM SCHOLARSHIP SCHEME FOR SPECIALLY ABLED STUDENT (Degree and Diploma)

1.0 OBJECTIVES OF THE SCHEME:

Saksham is a MHRD Scheme being implemented by of AICTE aimed at providing encouragement and support to specially abled children to pursue Technical Education. This is an attempt to give every young student, who is otherwise specially abled, the opportunity to study further and prepare for a successful future through technical education/knowledge.

2.0 ELIGIBILITY FOR SCHOLARSHIPS:

- 1) The candidate should be admitted to first year of Degree/Diploma level course OR Second year of Degree/Diploma course through lateral entry in any of the AICTE approved Institution of respective year.
- 2) Specially Abled Students, having disability of not less than 40%.
- 3) Family income from all sources is not more than Rs. 8 lakh per annum during the current financial year. A valid income certificate issued by State/UT Government need to be enclosed.

3.0 NUMBER OF SCHOLARSHIPS:

All eligible specially abled student admitted to first year of Degree/Diploma level course OR Second year of Degree/Diploma course through lateral entry in any of the AICTE approved Institution will get the scholarship.

4.0 AMOUNT OF SCHOLARSHIP:

- 1) Rs 50,000 per annum for every year of study i.e. maximum 4 years for Degree and 3 years for Diploma for first year admitted students and maximum 3 years for Degree and 2 years for Diploma for second year admitted students through lateral entry as lump sum amount towards payment of college fee, computer purchase, stationery, books, Equipment, Software's purchase etc. No other additional grant will be payable in lieu of hostel charges and medical charges etc.
- 2) No documentary proof need to be attached for the above while availing benefits.

5.0 MODE OF PAYMENT

After selection, the awardee will be paid scholarship through DBT mode on annual basis.

6.0 PROCEDURE FOR APPLYING

- 1) The candidate fulfilling the eligibility conditions is required to apply online on National Scholarship Portal (NSP) after initiation of application process and notice to be published on AICTE website.
- 2) The host institution where the candidate is studying is required to verify the online application.
- 3) Department of Technical Education (DTE) of respective State/ UT will verify these applications as second level of scrutiny.

7.0 RENEWALS

- 1) The scholarship will be renewed for the next year of study on receipt of renewal through National Scholarship Portal by submitting passing certificate/ marksheet along with letter from the Head of Institution in the online portal.
- 2) Student failing to get promoted to the next class/ level would forfeit the scholarship.

8.0 TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 1) Applications will be invited once in a year through National e-Scholarship Portal of the Government of India.
- 2) Incomplete applications will be summarily rejected. Only verified online applications will be considered for the award of scholarship.
- 3) If a candidate failed/ drop out in subsequent year, she will not be eligible for further scholarship.
- 4) Scheme will be implemented and monitored by the AICTE.
- 5) For converting CGPA (Cumulative Grade Point Average) to percentage, multiplying factor will be 9.5 i.e. to convert the CGPA into percentage, CGPA X 9.5 will give the percentage.
- 6) In case both CGPA & Total marks are given in the mark sheet, total marks will be considered for determining percentage.
- 7) If grades are given like A1, A2, B1, B2 etc in the mark sheet, first the grades will be converted into CGPA and then average CGPA will be calculated. This CGPA will be converted into percentage as given in point No. 2.
- 8) Provisional list of shortlisted candidates will be uploaded on the AICTE web portal. In case, candidate has any query about merit list of scholarship, they may raise their grievances within a month. No query regarding merit list will be entertained after one-month duration.
- 9) Query regarding non-payment of the scholarship due to invalid/wrong account number will be entertained only upto six months from the date of publishing of merit list on AICTE website.
