Record of Discussions of the meeting held under the Chairmanship of Shri Govind Mohan, Addl. Secretary (UT), MHA at 1500 hours on 27th September, 2019 in connection with observance of Birth Anniversary of Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel as Rashtriya Ekta Diwas (National Unity Day) on 31st October, 2019

A meeting was held under the Chairmanship of Shri Govind Mohan, Addl. Secretary (UT), MHA at 1500 hours on 27th September, 2019 in connection with the Rashtriya Ekta Diwas (National Unity Day) on 31st October, 2018. The list of participants is at **Annexed**.

2. Welcoming the participants, AS(UT) informed that the Hon'ble Home Minister has kindly consented to offer Floral Tributes at Patel Chowk and Flag Off the Run for Unity events in Delhi between 7.00 a.m. and 8.00 am. on 31.10.2019.

3. This was followed by detailed discussions on the preparedness of all the stakeholders for Floral Tribute and Run for Unity events on 31st October, 2019. The points emerged during the discussions and the decisions taken are as under:

- i. All the stakeholders to provide name and contact details of Nodal Officer in a day's time.

Floral Tribute

- ii. Representatives of NDMC and Delhi Police assured their readiness for Floral Tribute event.

Run for Unity:

- iii. The stakeholders assured arrangement of participation in the Run for Unity as follows: 3500 from CAPF; 2500 from Delhi Police; 1000 SAI athletes; 1000 from NSS/ NYKS; 300 ex-Servicemen by Ministry of Defence; 50 persons with disabilities by Department Of Empowerment of Persons with Disabilities and 3000 students from Educational institutions by Principal Secretary, Education, GNCTD. AS(UT) informed that in addition to the above participants, around 10000 persons from public will also participate in the event. Department Of

Empowerment of Persons with Disabilities was requested to share the list of participants and their coordinators with Delhi Police and be in touch with Delhi Police as in the last time. The Sports Authority of India (SAI) was requested to arrange prominent sports personalities for the Run and intimate MHA, at the earliest. SAI was also requested not to go ahead with any arrangement for participants with jogging club/ runners club.

- iv. It was agreed by the stakeholders that the requirement of T-Shirts for the Run including additional T-Shirts for the additional participants will be arranged as follows: NDMC-19000 (including DDA: 11000 and SAI: 2000); Delhi Police-6000; and Dte. Of Education/GNCTD-3000. EA(UT) assured that the approved design of the T-Shirt will be conveyed in 3-4 days' time.
- v. DDA agreed to arrange 15000 badges.
- vi. Regarding refreshment to ex-servicemen, Delhi Police was requested to arrange the same for ex-servicemen.
- vii. The stakeholders were informed that the suggestion of 'Registration of public online' for the Run was considered by competent authority and not agreed to.
- viii. SAI was requested to provide adequate power supply for operating equipment of Doordharshan.
- ix. SAI was requested to instruct the coaches to regulate and take forward the Run till its culmination point.
- x. The representative from All India Radio informed that the Ministry of Information & Broadcasting (MIB) has issued clear instructions to all its media units to give publicity and also coverage of Delhi events on 31.10.2019. The representatives were requested to provide video clips on Sardar Patel on or before 15th October, 2019, to get them screened in malls, multiplexes etc. Ministry of I&B was requested to arrange film personalities for the Run. As done in the previous years, catalogues on Sardar Patel may be handed over to CRPF for distribution.

- xi. NDMC and MCsD were requested to get the video clips on Sardar Patel screened in malls, multiplexes etc. under their respective jurisdiction.
- xii. Representative of DTC informed that DTC will ply around 250 trips from 4.00 a.m. in the morning and also after the run.
- xiii. It was decided to request Delhi Metro Rail Corporation (DMRC) to take up to start operation of the trains in the early hours on 31.10.2019 and also to operate additional trips before and after the Run.
- xiv. CPWD was asked to prepare stage for accommodating 17 to 18 persons. CPWD agreed to put up sufficient number of colored flags on both sides of the route of the Run. The request of Doordharshan for a sturdy arrangement for operating heavy equipment was conveyed to CPWD and CPWD & DD were requested to be in touch with each other on the issue for further action. CPWD was requested to provide around 3-4 media enclosures for the Run. It was also requested that bigger LCD screen may be arranged near the stage and better chairs may be arranged on the stage for VIPs and dignitaries.
- xv. As participation of around 25000 people is expected in the Run, all the stakeholder agencies were requested to make arrangements/ facilities including adequate mobile toilets to cater to all the participants.
- xvi. It was decided to request ADG(Media) to advice CPWD about the placement of media enclosures.
- xvii. All the stakeholders agreed to carry out activities as discussed during the meetings and action points.
- xviii. Representative of Delhi Police suggested field visit of all the stakeholders in the coming week.

4. Concluding the meeting, AS(UT) agreed for a field visit to Major Dhyan Chand National Stadium in the coming week and stated that the date and time will be intimated to all the stakeholders shortly.

The meeting ended with vote of thanks to the Chair.





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Record of Discussions of the meeting held under the Chairmanship of Shri Govind Mohan, Addl. Secretary (UT), MHA at 1500 hours on 17th September, 2019 in connection with observance of Birth Anniversary of Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel as Rashtriya Ekta Diwas (National Unity Day) on 31st October, 2019

A meeting was held under the Chairmanship of Shri Govind Mohan, Addl. Secretary (UT), MHA at 1500 hours on 17th September, 2019 in connection with the Rashtriya Ekta Diwas (National Unity Day) on 31st October, 2018. The list of participants is at **Annexure-I**.

2. Welcoming the participants, AS(UT) informed that the meeting is convened to chalk out the programme for observance of Rashtriya Ekta Diwas on 31.10.2019. He also informed that as has been done in the earlier years, the Major Dhyani Chand National Stadium may be the venue for 'Run for Unity' event and any change will be informed in the subsequent meetings.
3. EA(UT), MHA stated that the action points firmed up based on the programmes held in the recent years on the occasion of Rashtriya Ekta Diwas have already been conveyed to all the stakeholders along with the meeting notice and the same may be taken up for discussion. The issues discussed and decisions taken during the meeting are as under:
 - i. All the stakeholders present in the meeting agreed to carry out all the activities as has been done in the previous years as brought out in the Action Points.
 - ii. As regards participation by CAPFs in the Run for Unity, representative of P-II Division informed that due to deployment of the CAPFs for upcoming elections, for bypolls, in J&K, etc., they may not be able to arrange participation of 5000 personnel, instead will arrange around 3500 CAPF personnel for the Run. Delhi Police agreed to arrange participation of 2500 personnel of Delhi Police after taking stock of the trainees/ new recruits. It was decided to take up the issue of participation of ex-Servicemen and persons with disabilities separately as no representative of Ministry of Defence and Department of Empowerment of Persons with Disabilities attended the meeting.
 - iii. All the stakeholders agreed to arrange T-shirts as has been done earlier. Secretary, NDMC was requested to send a sample T-shirt in 2-3 days time for

approval of competent authority. After approval, NDMC agreed to share the design with Sports Authority of India (SAI), Hr. & Technical Education/ GNCTD, Delhi Development Authority (DDA) and Delhi Police. All the stakeholders were requested to get the T-shirts arranged well in advance and NDMC & DDA were requested to hand over the T-Shirts 15 days before the event to CSO/MHA for distribution.

- iv. DDA was asked to hand over a sample Badge for approval of competent authority within 2-3 days time.
- v. All the stakeholders were asked to arrange refreshments for their respective participants as per ceiling fixed vide Department of Expenditure OM dated 6th May, 2015 (**Annexure-II**). Delhi Police agreed to provide refreshments for ex-servicemen also as has been done last year.
- vi. Secretary, NDMC assured that NDMC will carry out all the activities as has been done by them in earlier occasions. NDMC agreed to get posters printed for the event. NDMC was requested to submit in 2-3 days' time the messages proposed to be printed in the posters for approval of competent authority. Regarding arrangement of water, NDMC informed that they will arrange Water Dispensers with paper cups.
- vii. The representative of SAI agreed to arrange Flag for 'Flag off', trainees, coaches, markers etc and also carry out all the activities as has been done last year. SAI was requested to arrange participation of cricketers also as part of the famous sports personalities arranged by them for the Run in Delhi.
- viii. Ministry of Information & Broadcasting (I&B) was requested to give publicity/ advertisement in print & electronic media 10 days before the event. AS(UT) requested I&B Ministry to plan and make a schedule for publicity and share with MHA. Ministry of I&B was also requested to provide short spots/ documentary on Sardar Patel and of the Unity Day event for screening in malls/ cinema halls etc. through MCsD and NDMC. Ministry of I&B was also requested to explore the participation of film personalities in the Run for Unity. Representatives of Doordharshan and All India Radio informed that they will give publicity, relay/ telecast programmes on Sardar Patel, give promos on the events planned and also will cover the programmes live in Delhi and all over the country.
- ix. Representative of DTC informed that they will ply around 250 additional trips from 4.00 a.m. in the morning of 31st October, 2019 if the Run for Unity is

planned between 7 a.m. and 8 a.m. On the request of representative of Department of Youth Affairs for conveyance to participants from NSS/NYKS, DTC agreed to provide buses on hiring basis. Department of Youth Affairs was requested to be in touch with DTC on the issue.

- x. Representative of PWD assured that they will carry out all the activities as in the last year. PWD was requested to ensure sufficient number of flags is put up in the route of the Run. PWD was also requested to get the stage ready 48 hours before the event, i.e. Run for Unity. PWD was assured of reimbursement of expenditure incurred in the arrangements by MHA as has been done in previous years.
 - xi. Jt. CP, Delhi Police informed that they will undertake all the activities listed in the Action Points.
 - xii. When suggestions were sought on additional activities that could be carried out during the current year's Run for Unity, the suggestions received during the meeting, inter-alia include, handing over posters to Delhi University to encourage voluntary participation of students of Delhi University in the Run for Unity, handing over of posters to Dte. of Hr. & Technical Education/GNCTD for distribution among Colleges under them, online registration of participants from public for the Run and circulation of video and audio bytes in social media publicizing the Run. Representative of SAI offered to contact jogging club/ runners club for participation in the Run and revert to MHA.
4. All the stakeholders were requested to convey the details of Nodal Officers along with their contact details to MHA immediately.
 5. Concluding the meeting, AS(UT) requested all the stakeholders to carry out the activities as agreed in the meeting in a time bound manner.
 6. The meeting ended with vote of thanks to the Chair.
