- To help them prepared for behavioural-based interview questions.

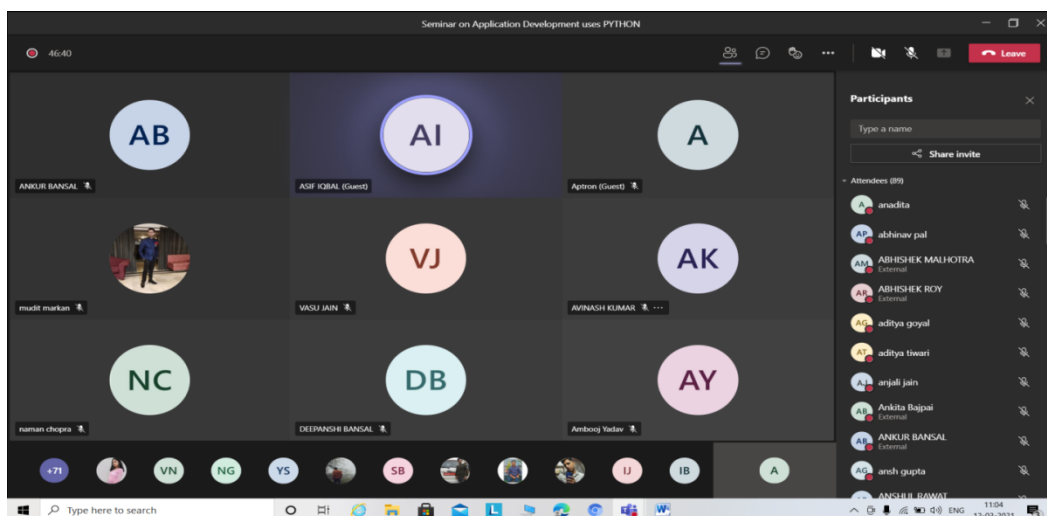
REPORT:
