AKAM-EBSB : Event in Virtual Mode

Background

Under Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav, the Ek Bharat Shreshtha Bharat prog has been selected for Iconic Activity during February 2022.

EBSB is a programme aimed at celebrating India's diversity through continuous, sustained engagement between people from different parts of the country. The engagements cover various aspects of life – language, society, culture, economy, food, festivals, tourist spots, sports and a lot more. States and UTs have been paired with each other, and engagements take place between paired states.

During the month of February 2022, D/o Higher Education is organizing Iconic Activity as part of Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav. Keeping in view the current situation due to Covid 19 wave, it has been decided to organize the activities in online mode.

1. <u>Guidelines for the event : Higher Education Institutions</u>

- All HEIs Central, State, Private can participate
- Each institution will identify an institution in their paired state and tie up with them for the programme. (as per list of EBSB state pairings attached at Annexure-III)
- Alternatively, institutions on both sides can team up in groups for the activities.
- Each institution / group of institutions can have a team of faculty and students coordinating the events, with one person assigned as Nodal person
- While selecting students for participation care must be taken have a balanced representation of girls, boys, students from different categories and different streams.
- Total participation from each HEI should be at least 25
- It should be ensured that at least 50 % of the participating students are active on social media.
- The possible areas of activities are suggested under the programme details. *This list is only indicative*.
- During the event it should be ensured that students from the paired states *share their ideas and experiences with each other*. There should be *active interaction between them*, which is the goal of Ek Bharat Shrehshtha Bharat.
- The programme will be spread over 20 days during which each pair of institution / group will be expected to do at least 5 activities
- Each activity has to be reported *preferably* on the day it is performed on EBSB Portal as well as AKAM Portal. Guidelines for reporting activities may be seen as mentioned below:

- A final report containing compilation of all activities should be submitted at the end of the programme.

2. <u>Online Interaction between paired institutions from paired states</u>

- HEIs from each state will conduct activities with HEIs of their paired states.
- Each of the HEI will constitute a team of faculty, with a Nodal Person for coordinating the activities with their partner institution in their paired states.
- The paired institutions will organize online activity between their students, based on the major themes under Ek Bharat Shreshtha Bharat including exchange based on culture, language, tourism, sports, cuisine, festivals.
- There can be presentation by cultural troupes of each state, lecdem, interaction with important cultural personalities literary figures, dancers, painters, singers etc.
- Virtual tour of important tourist attractions / monuments.
- Local Cuisine.
- Talk / presentation by experts regarding the lead industry / handicraft of the states.
- Quiz on each other's language introduction to the Bhasha Sangam App.
- Presentation on local / indigenous sports. Virtual meeting with important sportsperson of the states.
