- Language: Either Hindi (Mangal font size 12) or English (Times New Roman font size 12)
- 300 words.
- There will be grading of essay on the scale of 1-5.
- Grading will be done on the basis of content, language, clarity of thought and innovative ideas.
- Regional Director will assess and grade the essay by a suitable Committee at Regional level.
- Every Regional Director will send 400 entries on each topic on digital format and zip file to Directorate at the email id nsshqdelhi@gmail.com.
- Regional Directors are instructed to take special care to avoid contentious or controversial content in essays sent.

- 5. Regional Directors are directed to circulate this information among all Institutions under their jurisdiction for information and immediate time bound compliance.
- 6. The information pertaining to the Essay Writing should be started in such a way that the process completed by 21st December 2021 and all Regional Directors should be in a position to submit their report to Directorate of NSS by 23rd December 2021 positively.
- 7. The daily status of the submission of the essays to the Regional Director shall be submitted to the Directorate of NSS daily by 01.00 pm.
