REPORT:

Group Discussion activity was organized on 11th November'21 for BCA 2nd year students by the T&P cell of TIAS. The objective of this activity was to give the students a platform to express their views and opinions on a given topic; helping them enhance their thinking, listening and speaking skills, as these play a critical role during job placements. Evaluators and coordinators for the activity were Heena Lal (TPO) and Dr Sonal Dahiya (Associate Professor). Initially the Do's and Don'ts of a Group Discussion were reiterated to the students, post which the activity evaluation process was explained to the students. This was followed by the group discussion. The students were divided into four groups and separate topics were allotted to each group. The activity was structured in such a way that it promoted an informal exchange of knowledge, ideas, and perceptions among the participants. Contributions were pooled together and examined in terms of their relevance and validity. The session was very interactive and was well received by the 19 students who participated in the group discussion. Post the session, Ms Heena Lal and Dr. Sonal Dahiya guided the students regarding their scope of improvement in respective areas.
