#### -: Choice Based Credit System (CBCS):-

The CBCS provides an opportunity for the students to choose courses from the prescribed courses comprising core, elective/minor or skill based courses.

Types of courses in Choice Based Credit System (CBCS)

#### 1.1 Core Course:

A course, which should compulsorily be studied by a candidate as a core requirement is termed as a Core course.

#### 1.2 Elective Course:

Generally a course which can be chosen from a pool of courses and which may be very specific or specialized or advanced or supportive to the discipline/ subject of study or which provides an extended scope or which enables an exposure to some other discipline/subject/domain or nurtures the candidate's proficiency/skill is called an Elective Course.

- (a) **Discipline Specific Elective (DSE) Course:** Elective courses offered by the main discipline/subject of study are referred to as Discipline Specific Electives.
- (b) **Project work/Dissertation:** is considered as a special course involving application of knowledge in solving / analyzing /exploring a real life situation / difficult problem. A candidate studies such a course on his own with an advisory support by a teacher/faculty member. The work done will have to be submitted in writing as a dissertation.
- (c) **Generic Elective (GE) Course:** Elective courses that are generic or interdisciplinary by nature chosen from an unrelated discipline/ subject with an intention to seek exposure beyond discipline/s of choice are called Generic Electives. Students will have to choose one elective each in the first four semesters from the lists GE1 to GE4 given in this syllabus.

### 1.3 Ability Enhancement Courses (AEC):

The Ability Enhancement (AE) Courses are the course that leads to Knowledge enhancement. These are of two types.

- (a) **AE Compulsory Course (AECC):** Environmental Studies, English Communication / Modern Indian Language (MIL) Communication.
- (b) AE Elective Course (AEEC): AEEC courses are value-based and/or skill-based and are aimed at providing hands-on-training, competencies, skills, etc. These courses are to be chosen from a pool of courses designed to provide value-based and/or skill-based instruction.

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
