Sub: Decision of Academic Council for inclusion of NSS/NCC and offering 2 credits (NUES) in the curriculum in all Courses of Study under each School and its Affiliated Colleges running UG/PG/Ph.D program-Reg.

With reference to queries raised by some Deans of University Schools and based on the circular issued by the Director Academic Affairs (DAA) (Annexure-I) and decision of the Academic Council in incorporating 2 credits NUES course in offering NSS programmes/ NCC programs in the entire course curriculum being offered by the University through its Schools of study, being run at the main campus and all affiliated colleges under GGSIP University.

As per the decision of the Academic council, NCC/NSS are to be offered by incorporating in the scheme of study of each course so as to enable the student to opt for the same starting from the Academic year 2021-22.

Keeping in view, the queries raised by some Dean, the following clarifications are given:

- 1. GGSIPU NSS Cell shall monitor the activities of both NSS and NCC.
- It is advised that the Board of Studies (BoS) of each school incorporates NSS/NCC programs during the 1st semester onwards and two credits be assigned either at the end of 6th Semester (for a three year and four year degree courses) and may consider

giving at the 8th semester (for a five year degree course). (Suggestive Template given at Annexure-II).

- 3. The evaluation criteria as decided by Academic Council for NCC is as follows:
 - a. The student who has successfully completed the said programme as per guidelines shall be awarded two credits after the same is duly approved by NSS/NCC cell and recommended by the Controller of Examination to post two credits as per decision of the Board of Studies of each school.
 - b. The criteria for awarding two credits for NCC, the duration of the training shall be spread across 4 semesters and the student should achieve 'B' Certificate to earn the 2 credits under NUES. All the procedures shall be binding on the student as per the NCC Manual and are suppose to qualify the certification examination for each level. The procedure for earning the same is given at *Annexure-III*. The student/cadet is allowed to complete 'C' level certification based on his interest to continue during the Third year.
 - c. Appointment of Officers: The Associate NCC Officers will be appointed from among the interested teaching faculty (male/ female) willing to take up additional responsibilities of teaching and training of NCC Cadets. The duties, powers, functions, Honorarium and other perks of such officers will be followed as per the NCC Manual.
 - d. Teaching and Training will be handled by ANOs and shortlisting process in each year will be done by GGSIPU NSS/NCC Cell.
- 4. The evaluation criteria as decided by Academic Council for NSS is as follows:
 - a. Induction into NSS is on voluntary basis and students both boys and girls can join at the age of 17 and is studying at the University Campus or Affiliated colleges under GGSIPU.
 - b. The student who has successfully completed the said programme (Regular NSS activities completed 240 hours in two years along with done an annual Special Camp activity) as per NSS Manual shall be awarded two credits (NUES) after the same is duly approved by NSS/NCC cell and recommended by the Controller of Examination to post two credits as per decision of the Board of Studies of each school.
 - c. The duration of the said programme shall be spread across four semesters (minimum) and the student should complete successfully the number of hours

prescribed in doing regular and special camping activities as per NSS manual to earn the two credits under NUES.

- d. All the procedures shall be binding on the student as per the NSS Manual and are suppose to qualify for earning NSS Certificate.
- e. The student/Volunteer is allowed to complete the prescribed hours of work within 2 years or four semesters as prescribed in the curriculum. He may wish to volunteer based on his interest to continue during the subsequent years of study by the student in the university system.
- f. Each college/ university can have more than one NSS unit raised depending on the number of students enrolled. Usually, a NSS Unit comprises of minimum 70 students and upto a maximum of 120 students and handled by one Program Officer. For each unit a Head boy and a Head girl will be nominated by the concerned program officer.
- g. Appointment of Officers: Appointment of NSS officers, designated as Program officers from among the teaching faculty of the school is done by each school depending upon the number of Units being raised. The same will be got approved by the GGSIPU NSS Cell from the Competent Authority. The University may prescribe the duties, powers and functions of such officers as per the NSS Manual. Such officers may be given incentives by the University both monetary and consider part of work load as decided by the Competent Authority.
- h. School may provision a common two hour slot in a week for faculty to interact with NSS Volunteers.

Annexure-III

ELIGIBILITY CONDITION FOR CERTIFICATE EXAMINATION FOR NCC

(a) 'A' Certificate

- (i) The candidate must have attended a minimum of 75% of total training periods laid down in the syllabus for the first and second years of Junior Division/ Wing NCC (All Wings).
- (ii) Must have attended one Annual Training Camp.

(b) 'B' Certificate

- (i) The cadet must have attended a minimum of 75% of total training period laid down in the syllabus for the first and second years for Senior Division Wing NCC (All Wings).
- Must have attended one Annual Training Camp/NIC.
- (iii) Cadets possessing 'A' certificate will be awarded 10 bonus marks.
- (iv) An Air Wing Cadet must do a minimum of 10 Glide Launches.

(c) 'C' Certificate

- (i) The candidate must be in possession of Certificate 'B'.
- The cadet must be in third year of SD/SW NCC Training.
- (iii) The cadet must have attended a minimum of 75% of the periods of 3rd year syllabus during the academic session.
- (iv) Must have attended Two ATCs or one ATC and in addition one of the following:-
 - (aa) RD Camp at Delhi (RDC).
 - (ab) Centrally Organised Camp (COC).
 - (ac) Para Training Camp (PTC).
 - (ad) National Integration Camp (NIC) (when applicable for SD/SW Cadets).
 - (ae) All India Trekking Expedition (DG NCC organised).
 - (af) All India Mountaineering Expedition (DG NCC organised).
 - (ag) Attachment Training with Service units.
 - (ah) Any one of the Adventure Courses approved by DG NCC.
 - Sailing Expedition, with actual sailing exceeding 10 days, duly approved by DG NCC.
 - (ak) Ay cadet participating in National Rifle Association India (NRAI) matches as part of DG NCC team.



- (al) Special Services Camps (essentially with 50% Service training).
- (am) Successfully done Scuba Diving Course.
- (an) Youth Exchange Programme.
- (ao) Foreign cruise (Navy).

Grading procedure:

- (i) A cadet has to obtain 45% marks in each paper and 50% marks in the aggregate to pass the examinations. Grading based on total marks obtained will be awarded as follows:-
 - (aa) Grading 'A' Cadets obtaining 80% marks or above.
 - (ab) Grading 'B' Cadets obtaining 65% marks and above but below 80%
 - (ac) Grading 'C' Cadets obtaining 50% marks and above but below 65%.
 - (ad) Fail Cadets obtaining less than 45% in any Paper or less than 50% of the aggregate.

Several incentives are being provided for NCC Cadets on successful completion of the certificates.

From time to time Central and State Governments announce number of incentives for NCC Cadets. These incentives are in the field of employment as well as academics and personal incentives including medals, trophies, cash awards etc. Some are listed as under:-
