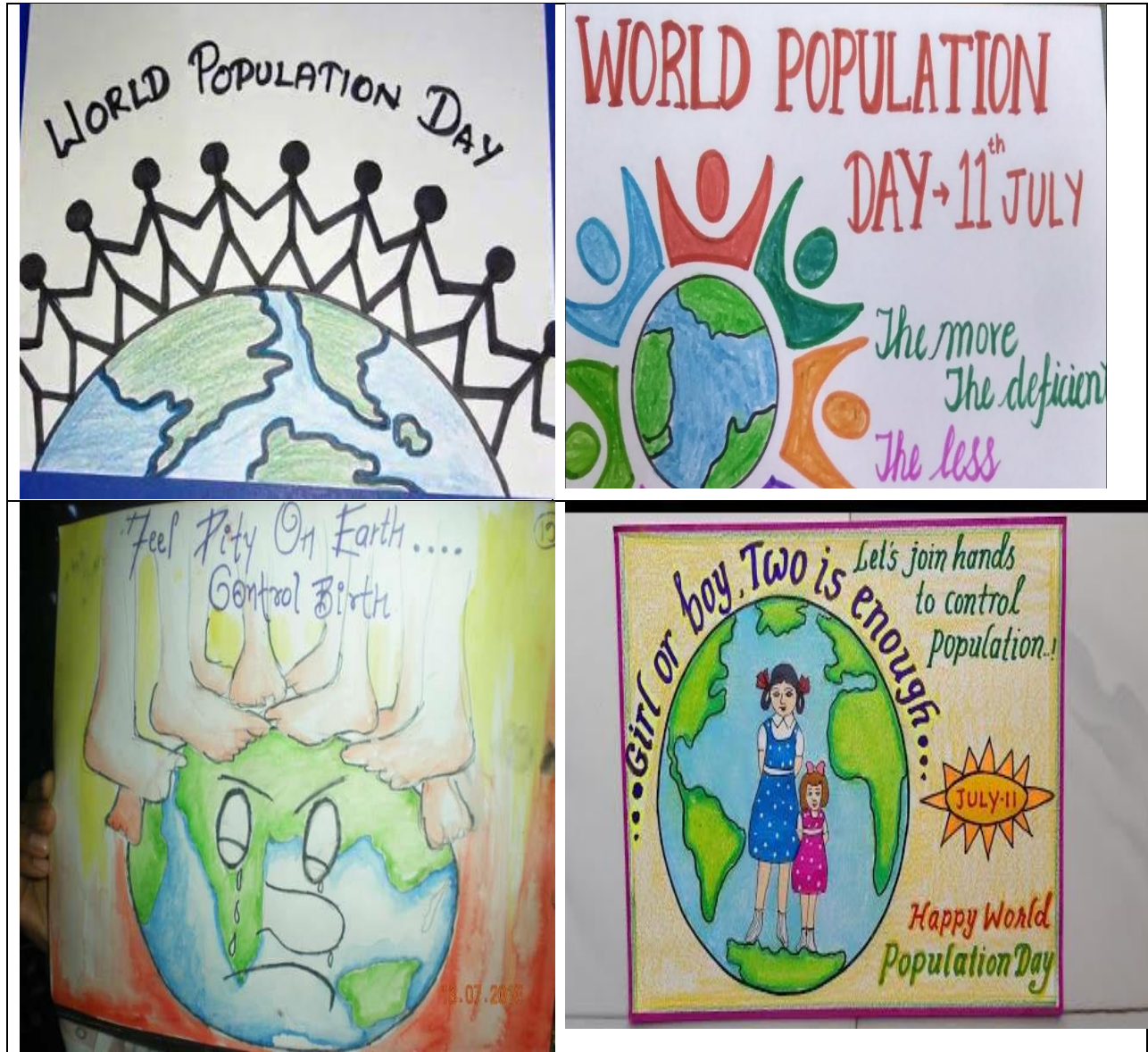
On this day our NSS volunteers participated in Poster Making Competition regarding the control of population. Nearly 35 volunteers took part in the painting competition.
