REPORT:

Group Discussion activity was organized on 7th March'22 for BCA 3rd year students by the T&P cell of TIAS. The objective of this activity was to give the students a platform to express their views and opinions on a given topic; helping them enhance their thinking, listening and speaking skills, as these play a critical role during job placements. Evaluators and coordinators for the activity were Heena Lal (TPO) and Ms. Sangeeta (Assistant Professor). Initially the Do's and Don'ts of a Group Discussion were reiterated to the students, post which the activity evaluation process was explained to the students. This was followed by the group discussion. The students were divided into two groups and separate topics were allotted to each group. The session was very interactive and was well received by the 12 students who participated in the group discussion. 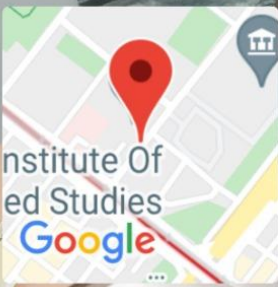
LEARNING OUTCOME:
