6. We should not make unnecessary use of electric heaters and air conditioners without need.
7. We should get our personal vehicles repaired from time to time and drive better to reduce pollution.
8. We should turn off the lights, fans and other electrical appliances to reduce the use of electricity.
9. We should plant more and more trees in our surrounding areas to reduce the effect of pollution and greenhouse gas.
