Constitution Day is celebrated in Tecnia Institute of Advanced Studies on 26th November, 2019 as a part of celebration of 70th Anniversary of Adoption of the Constitution of India “SAMVIDHAN DIVAS”. The event commenced at 10:00 am. The programme formally commenced by the warm inaugural session by Dr. Kanika Gupta.

NATIONAL ANTHEM BY DR AJAY KUMAR, DIRECTOR, TIAS FACULTIES AND STUDENT TO GRACE THE OCCASION

Then the welcome address was given by Director Ajay Kumar on Constitution of India. In his address, he said that “The constitution is the foundation of the country's political system under which its people are governed. Constitution of any State legislature, executive and judiciary wings establishes their powers, the demarcation of their obligations and regulates their relations with the public. Infact, each of the ideals of its founders and creators of the Constitution is the mirror of the values and dreams of the people and is based on the specific social, political and economic goals and faith and aspirations of its people. He said that the Indian Constitution is unique, flexible and highly practical. He said, “The Preamble reflects the philosophy as well as fundamental values of Indian Constitution adopted on 26th November, 1949. It clarifies important aspects, viz.(i) the Constitution derives its Authority from the people of India, (ii) it declares India to be sovereign, socialist, secular, democratic and republic country, and (iii) it clarifies that the objectives of the Constitution are Justice, Liberty, Equality and Fraternity.”

Afterwards Dr.Rohtash Kumar spoke on the meaning of the Preamble and explained the various philosophy of the Constitution through the meaning of Justice, Liberty, Equality and Fraternity. He highlighted the attainment of Fraternity through Liberty and Equality. Every aspect was explained in very simple language and through stories depicting day-to-day happenings. He further said, “basic tenets of our constitution are “Freedom of Mind” and “Welfare” as key to country’s development. Constitution provides a scientific approach to manage a society.

Than Pledge was taken by Director, faculty, students and at Tecnia Institute of Advanced Studies. In order to mark and acknowledge the contribution of the framers of the Constitution and to aggravate the people regarding the prominent values, 26th November is celebrated as 'Constitution Day'.

and to promote among them all

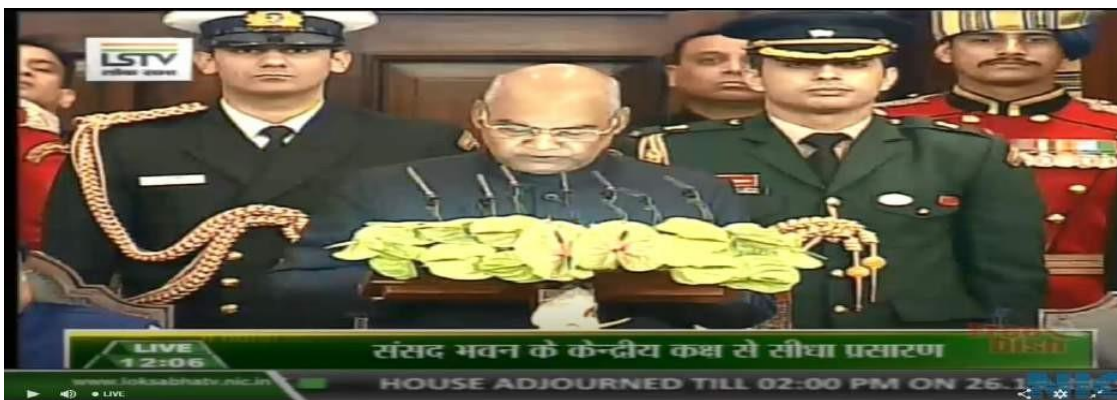
FRATERNITY assuring the dignity of the individual and the unity and integrity of the Nation;

Indian Constitution describes the fundamental political code, structure, procedures, powers, and duties of the government institutions. It also explains fundamental rights, directive principles and the duties of citizens. India's constitution is the longest written constitution in the world. It took around 2 years, 11 months and 17 days to complete the Constitution.

Therefore, National Constitution Day is celebrated on 26 November to commemorate the adoption of the Constitution of India.
