## 2.4 Other significant Achievement of the Month (Must): \*

1) NSS Cell of Tecnia Institute of Advanced Studies and Ashtavakra Institute of Rehabilitation Sciences and Research\* in association with ONGC and Torch IT has organised a camp on dated 09.06.2022 for person with Locomotor disabilities where 'Handicare – Assistive Mobility Device for Lower Limb Disability' has been distributed free of cost

### Description:

People suffering from lower limb disability suffer intense pain and embarrassment to walking in confined or congested setups as wheelchair availability & accessibility in these areas is a major challenge. Understanding that pain, we invented our device which allows the user to walk with complete ease and comfort without having any push from any body part.

The product works on maneuvering mechanics where there are handle bars, that can be wiggled right or left such that the front wheels can be maneuvered for easier indoor mobility. This leads to less friction between the bigger wheels and the ground thereby enabling navigation with the least amount of effort. This main motive for inventing the device was to provide ease of transportation for indoor as well as soft outdoor purposes for people suffering from severe lower limb disability. The design of the vehicle is made in such a way that it is portable and can be carried anywhere. Moreover, this vehicle can be used for indoor purposes where other vehicles like wheelchairs cannot be used. The basic advantage of this device is that it can be used in narrow places also like washrooms and bedrooms where other devices cannot reach due to their size.
