Dear IIC President / Convener,

Greetings from MoE's Innovation Cell, AICTE

As most of you are aware that MIC has launched the Innovation Ambassador Training Program for IIC Institutions during the IIC2.0(2019-20) calendar year and it was started with physical trainings conducted in different states on four major themes i.e. Design thinking & Innovations, Entrepreneurship Development, IPR, Pre-incubation & Incubation. But due to COVID19 pandemic the training went online on similar themes. Through these physical and online training sessions in IIC2.0 and IIC3.0, approx 12000 Innovation Ambassadors got trained and these IAs are playing the role by aligning their efforts in generating awareness, leading, coordination and delivering I&E activities in campus and nearby communities as part of activities conducted by the IIC-Institutions.

Similarly, in IIC4.0 calendar year (2021-22) ,we came up with online Innovation Ambassador Training Program for Foundation Level, Advanced Level and Up-skilling & Re-skilling level. So, the nominations and training has begun and is described below:

1. For Foundation Level Training, IIC President / Convener can nominate a maximum 10 new IIC members (Faculty / non-teaching staff) from the IIC login at https://iic.mic.gov.in/login under Innovation Ambassador menu. These nominations will remain open throughout the current calendar year so that each member must get IA training.

During the nomination, each nominated member will receive the login credentials over their registered email id to complete the training (video session and assessments). After successful completion of all assessments, the download certificate will be reflected in the portal itself.

2. For Advanced Level Training, nominations are not required as the member can directly login with the credentials they had last year in Foundation Level Training.

(Note: If one has not completed the Foundation Level training last year, then they need to first complete that to be eligible for Advanced Level)

After successful completion of all assessments, the download certificate will be reflected in the portal itself.

3. For Up-skilling & Re-skilling Level Training, nominations are not required as the member can directly login with the credentials they had last vear in Advanced Level Training

(Note: If one has not completed the Advanced Level training last year, then they need to first complete that to be eligible for Upskilling and Re-skilling)

After successful completion of all assessments, the download certificate will be reflected in the portal itself.

Also, IIC president / Convener will be able to track the status of the participants in the IIC Login those who are undergoing Innovation Ambassador training.

Important points to remember

- 1- After nominating any member, that member can only be replaced (delete) if he/she has not started the training.
- 2. If you deleted any member from IA nomination list even after he /she has started / completed the session, the nomination will be counted from total count i.e. from 10.
- 3. While nominating please cross check the name and email-id to avoid login and certificate issues.
