It is enlightening to share with you that the IIC network has grown to 4000+ numbers of HEIs and the Institutions Innovation Council (IIC) has become a successful model for HEIs to build, streamline, strengthen and drive campus innovation and startup ecosystems in India. Moreover, the IIC network has turned out to be instrumental in building Intra and inter-institutional partnerships and cooperation which has sped up the IP generation, innovation, and startup outputs from academic institutions by improving I&E awareness level, trained human resources, and pre-incubation/incubation facilities in HEIs. Similarly, more than 3000+ HEIs are also participating in the Atal Ranking of Institutions in Innovation Achievements (ARIIA) which turns to provide a measurable framework for HEIs to benchmark the I&E ecosystem that exists in educational institutions and set directions in improving the I&E ecosystem through better planning and resource mobilization strategy. Furthermore, 2500+ HEIs have started adopting National Innovation and Startup Policy (NISIP) by formulating I&E policy Action Plans (outcome-based) for their institute and timely implementation of the same. To unleash the HEIs potential up to its fullest capacity, all three major programs NISIP, IIC and ARIIA are now implemented in an integrated and coordinated fashion.

The Ministry of Education's Innovation Cell announces two MIC Driven Activities for IIC4.0 as follows;

I. To make the IIC network more vibrant, proactive, collaborative and productive, the Ministry of Education's Innovation Cell and AICTE is going to organise 15 IIC regional meets in different cities across the country to bring existing and prospective IIC institutions together, to provide a platform for sharing I&E knowledge and best practices in HEIs, to celebrate the achievements and impact created by IIC Institutions and to witness successful emergence of innovators and startup founders from HEIs. In this regard, your IIC Institution is requested to nominate faculty representatives (minimum 1 and maximum 4 members) to take part in the regional meet. IIC institute is encouraged to nominate representatives for different knowledge sharing & orientation sessions on IIC, NISIP, ARIIA and IP. Nominations should be submitted through the IIC portal only, and preferably select a city of your zone. IIC institutions are also invited to take part in the IIC Poster Gallery round to be held during the regional meet. This will be a demonstration platform for participating IIC institutions to showcase institutions' innovation and entrepreneurship ecosystem preparedness, models/best practices, contributions, recent achievements and impacts made in the last 2 academic years 2020-21, 2021-22. For this, IIC institute is expected to prepare a poster in the form of Roll up Standee of size 6 by 3 feet size for display during the regional meet. II. Building YUKTI - National Innovation Repository (NIR) at the IIC institute level by regularly/round the year scouting ideas, innovations, and start-ups developed by students, recent graduates, alumni members, and faculty members, staff, entrepreneurs who received incubation support from the institute. Further, conducting verification of these scouted entries and providing various supporting actions in terms of mentoring, pre-incubation support, linkage with incubation unit, connection with Angel/VC investment, facilitating IP generation and technology Transfer, nominating for participation in national challenges, etc. IIC institutions can manage to build the innovation repository through the 'YUKTI' tab placed on the IIC login page and can also download guideline documents for participants and IIC institutions. Innovations and Ventures/Start-ups (verified by HEI with Recommended status) repository created by the IIC Institute (HEI) as part of the YUKTI - National Innovation Repository initiative of the MoE's Innovation Cell will be auto-pooled and reflected in the data section and further counted in the ARIIA 2022 ranking.
