Call to Higher Educational Institutions to be part of UBA

Till Now 426 Technical and 262 Non-Technical Institutions are part of UBA

Eligibility

- Any recognized Higher Educational Institution (Centre & State) already involved in development activities.
- Should have at least 500 students, excluding first and final year students.
- Should have identified at least 5 villages in their vicinity.
- Should have at least 2 Faculty members who are involved with development activities in rural areas.

Operation

- Selected educational institutions to engage at Panchayat level in chosen villages.
- Assess need, formulate/Identify/Customise solutions-technological or otherwise.
- MHRD to assist in training and gap funding for technical solutions.

Application

- Apply only online at unnat.iitd.ac.in
- Portal open from 10 a.m on 1st September, 2018
- **The last date for submission of applications is 20th September, 2018 till 5 p.m.**
- On challenge mode the best institutes to be selected.
- Announcement of new selected institutions on 2nd October, 2018.
