A blood donation camp was organized by National Service Scheme of Tecnia Institute of Advanced Studies, Rohini & Rotory Club of Delhi Rajdhani in Multipurpose Hall, PG Building of TIAS campus from 10:00 AM to 4:00 PM. The Camp was inaugurated by Mr. Vijay K. Jain, President, Rotary Club of Delhi Rajdhani, Dr. Ajay Kumar, Director, Tecnia Institute of Advanced Studies, Dr. A. K.
