Dear Sir/Madam,

The Ministry of Education's Innovation Cell (MIC) is thanking all our IIC institutions for their persistent efforts and continuous support to enable HEIs in leading and driving the I & E ecosystem in the country.

The impressive journey so far started with mere 400+ institutions in 2018 to 4000+ HEIs with Institution's Innovation Councils (IICs) in 2022 is really a phenomenon, and building confidence of "Yes We Can" among all the stakeholders.

Taking this national innovation and startup momentum forward, especially driven by educational institutions in forefront, MIC will request all IIC institutions for their active participation in three major policy programs; Annual Performance of IIC4.0, Atal Ranking of Institutions on Innovation Achievement (ARIIA) 2022 ranking exercise and Adoption of National Innovation and Startup Policy (NISP) in HEIs. Above three policy programs are now acting in an integrated fashion to maximize the efficiency and effectiveness of HEIs towards harnessing its innovation and entrepreneurship capacities and capabilities.

Suggestive Actions for IIC institutions in the IIC portal (refresh Ctrl+Shift+R for latest features) for Enhancing IIC Institution's Performance in IIC4.0, ARIIA 2022 and NISP Adoption by 31st August 2022:

- 1. Ensure timely conduct and submission of I&E activities (IIC Driven, Self-Driven and MIC- Driven) conducted as part of IIC4.0 calendar year by 31st August 2022. Newly/recently joined IIC institutions can submit the I&E activities conducted even prior to registration of IIC but those should be during the part of IIC 4.0 (1st Sept ,2021 onwards) as Self-Driven Activity in the IIC portal for consideration of IIC4.0 annual performance assessment. The annual performance of IIC institutions in IIC4.0 will be auto considered for the ARIIA 2022 ranking.
- 2. Ensure nomination of up to 10 faculty IIC members to undergo and completion of Innovation Ambassadors (BASIC level) training and Advance level training for already enrolled innovation ambassadors. Nomination of Faculty for IA BASIC level training can be managed in IIC-institution's login page whereas already enrolled Innovation ambassadors can complete the ADVANCE level in their respective IA login page. Furthermore, post-training, the performance of Innovation Ambassadors in terms of reporting volunteer activities as prescribed will reflect in the IIC 4.0 and ARIIA 2022 performance. The status of IA training completion and their performance as on 31st August 2022 will be auto considered for the ARIIA 2022 ranking. Performance of IA also carries weightages in IIC4.0 annual performance. (Note: IA nomination for basic training and Advance Training by Innovation Ambassadors is open round the year).
- 3. Add/update pre-incubation, incubation, IPR Cell and Technology Transfer Unit infrastructure facility details which are existing in the institute. This can be managed through the 'Pre-incubation/incubation' tab placed in the IIC-institute login page, and updated information as on 31st August 2022 will be considered for the ARIIA 2022 ranking and weightages in IIC4.0 annual performance.
- 4. Ensure building YUKTI National Innovation Repository (NIR) at the IIC institute level by regularly/round the year scouting of ideas, innovations, and start-ups developed by students, recent graduates, alumni members, faculty members, staffs, entrepreneurs and entrepreneurs received incubation support from the institute. Further, conducting verification of these scouted entries and providing various supporting actions in terms of mentoring, pre-incubation support, linkage with incubation unit, connection with Angel/VC investment, facilitating IP generation and technology Transfer, nominating for participation in national challenges etc. IIC institutions can manage building the innovation repository through the 'YUKTI' tab placed in the IIC login page and can also download guideline documents for participants and IIC institutions. Applicants can submit directly through https://yukti.mic.gov.in/. Innovations and Ventures/Start-ups (verified by IIC institute with Recommended status) repository created by the IIC Institute (HEI) as part of the YUKTI - National Innovation Repository initiative of the MoE's Innovation Cell, the status of the same as on 31st August 2022 will be auto considered for the ARIIA 2022 ranking.
- 5. Ensure IIC institution's registration in the NISP portal and actions taken towards formulation of Innovation and Startup Policy at the HEI level and implementation of the policy action plans. The progress made in adoption of National Innovation and Startup Policy (NISP) in HEIs in terms of formulation and implementation of I&E policy at the HEI level, the status of the same as on 31st August 2022 will be auto-pooled and considered for the ARIIA 2022 ranking.
- 6. Ensure IIC Institution's participation in selecting up to three ATL Tinkering labs established in school to provide mentoring support in promoting and supporting innovation and entrepreneurship in schools and also engaging IIC members in guiding school students in their innovation assignments. This can be managed through the 'ATL Tinkering Linkage' tab placed in the IIC-institute login page and it carries weightages in IIC4.0 annual performance. Prescribed I&E activities section for the Academic year 2022-23, (IIC 5.0) will be activated by the end of the IIC4.0 period.
- 7. Timely completion of Impact lectures (31st July 2002), mentor-mentee programs (31st Aug 2022) (if your institute is part of any of these schemes) and it carries weightages in IIC4.0 annual performance.

- - 8. Refereeing HEIs that have not yet established IIC and encouraging them to join the IIC network by 31st of August 2022. This carries weightages in IIC4.0 annual performance.
 - 9. Afflicting University to invite their affiliated HEIs to register and establish IICs by 31st of August 2022. For this, affiliating universities will get extra weightages in IIC4.0 annual performance.
 - 10. IIC institute to upload e-learning sessions on innovation and entrepreneurship and IPR conducted by it in the last 3 academic year/IIC calendar period as part of the e-Learning Repository creation by 31st of August 2022. This carries weightages in IIC4.0 annual performance.
 - 11. Upload of an Annual report for the IIC4.0 of your IIC Institute with a designed brochure by 31st of August 2022. This carries weightages in IIC4.0 annual performance
 - 12. Submission of 3-4 text testimonials and 2-3 video testimonials from top authorities/chief functionaries of the IIC institute regarding IIC and Institution's contribution by 31st of August 2022.
 - 13. Nomination and participation of representatives from IIC institute in the IIC Regional Meet. Participation of IIC institute in IIC region meet will help in performing better in IIC4.0, NISP adoption and ARIIA 2022 ranking. IIC institute is also invited to take part in the IIC Poster Gallery round to be held during the regional meet. This will be a demonstration platform for participating IIC institutions to showcase institutions' innovation and entrepreneurship ecosystem preparedness, models/best practices, contributions, recent achievements and impacts made in the last 2 academic years 2020-21, 2021-22. For this, IIC institute is expected to prepare a poster in the form of Roll up Standee of size 6 by 3 feet size for display during the regional meet. Best posters from IIC institutions will be identified and felicitated during the regional meet.
