Greetings from the Ministry of Education's Innovation Cell (MIC) !!!

Hope you are all aware that the IIC4.0 calendar year is about to end on 31st August 2022 and the new IIC 5.0 calendar year will begin from 1st Sept. onwards.

This year, more than 4000 IIC institutions are part of the network submitting reports for the innovation and entrepreneurship-related activities that were organised by your institute during the IIC4.0 (the academic year 2021-22) period and competing for a better position in the IIC 4.0 Annual Performance. IIC 4.0 performance result is likely to be published in the month of October 2022. **The last date (extended) for submission of reports for the I&E activities organised till 31st August 2022 in the IIC portal is 11th September 2022.**

- If your institute has not yet established IIC, please register and establish IIC <https://iic.mic.gov.in/>
- If your institute has not yet registered for ARIIA, please register and participate at aria.gov.in
- If your institute has not yet started adopting NISP, please register and start adopting at <https://nisp.mic.gov.in/>

Please note that if your institution has established/registered an IIC recently or after Q1 & Q2 period, still your institute can submit innovation and entrepreneurship-related activities that were organised by your institute during (Q1 & Q2) period (1st Sept. 2021 onwards) under the self-Driven activity category and Celebration activity category for consideration. For the (Q3 and Q4) period, IIC institutions can organise I&E activities till 31st August 2022 and upload the reports under four different categories such as IIC Calendar activities, Self-Driven Activities, MIC Driven Activities, and Celebration Activities to get the maximum starts in IIC 4.0 Annual Performance.

Further, please note that the performance of IIC institutions (in terms of stars obtained in IIC 4.0 annual performance) will be used for preparing a new list of Mentor institutions and the performance also will be auto-fed into the ARIIA framework data submission portal (parameter/section 1. ii) for ranking of HEIs. In addition to this, best-performing institutions will get various benefits and accessibility to various I&E programs and schemes available at MIC and AICTE.

Similarly, the number of trained IIC faculty members as Innovation Ambassadors and their activeness and performance during post-training in terms of conduct and upload of prescribed I&E activities is also very much needed for IIC institutions to improve their performance in both IIC 4.0 Annual Assessment and ARIIA data submission portal (parameter/section 1. iii). Therefore, all IIC Institutions are required to undertake necessary actions to nominate faculty (maximum 10 numbers per year) for IA training (Open throughout the year and run in a self-paced mode) and their active & volunteer contribution during post-training to retain the Innovation Ambassador tag. More importantly, as part of YUKTI - National Innovation Repository initiative, now IAs can also perform as mentors and verify innovation applications scouted under it. Furthermore, the best effort of IAs will be recognized and rewarded both at the institute and MIC levels.






Another major role of IIC institutions is to create and build INNOVATION REPOSITORY (YUKTI - NIR) at the institute level by identifying, scouting, verifying, and providing necessary handholding support to these ideas, innovations, and startups by using the IIC and YUKTI platform. Moreover, the verified and recommended innovations (TRL 4 and above) and startups will be auto populated in the ARIIA 2022 Data Submission Portal (parameter/section 4 and 5) for further action. Other important actions for IIC Institutions that should not be missed/ignored, these are likely to impact their performance in IIC 4.0 and ARIIA 2022 are as follows;

1. Referral and invite other HEIs in your region and network to join the IIC network (submission status as on 11th Sept. 2022) and get points credit to the IIC account. Similarly, Afflicting University is required to invite/add their affiliated HEIs to register in the IIC portal to establish IICs (status as on 31st of August 2022) to get weightages in IIC4.0 annual performance.
2. Update the progress made in the adoption of the National Innovation and Startup Policy (NISP) (status as on 11th Sept. 2022); Formulation I&E policy at the Institute level and Developed Action Plan with KPIs, Timeline & Milestones for Implementation with the involvement of the IIC team. Progress on NISP adoption will be auto-reflected in ARIIA (Parameter/section 1.i).
3. Edit/add/update pre-incubation, incubation, IPR Cell and Technology Transfer Unit infrastructure facility available at your institute in the IIC portal (submission status as on 11th Sept. 2022), which will be made accessible to other IIC institutions to reach out for support. This carries weightages in the IIC4.0 annual performance and ARIIA framework (parameter/section 3).
4. IIC Institutions are required to establish linkage (managed through the IIC portal and submission status as on 11th Sept. 2022)) with Atal Tinkering Labs (ATLs)/School Innovation Councils (SICs) in Schools (up to 3 numbers) as mentor institute. The mentoring activities for the ATLs will start in the IIC 5.0 (AY 2022-23) period.

5. Timely submission of reports for the Impact lectures, and Mentor-Mentee programs (submission Status as on 11th Sept. 2022) (if your institute is part of any of these schemes) to get weightages in IIC4.0 annual performance scorecard.
6. IIC institutions are required to upload video URL of expert talks on innovation and entrepreneurship and IPR conducted during the last 3 academic years/IIC calendar periods as part of the e-Learning Repository in the IIC portal (submission status as on 11th Sept. 2022) to get weightages in IIC4.0 annual performance.
7. IIC institutions are required to upload the IIC 4.0 Annual report of your IIC Institute with a designed brochure (submission status as on 11th Sept. 2022) to get weightages in IIC4.0 annual performance.
8. Submission of 3-4 text testimonials and 2-3 video testimonials from top authorities/chief functionaries of the IIC institute regarding IIC and the Institution's contribution (submission status as on 11th Sept. 2022).
