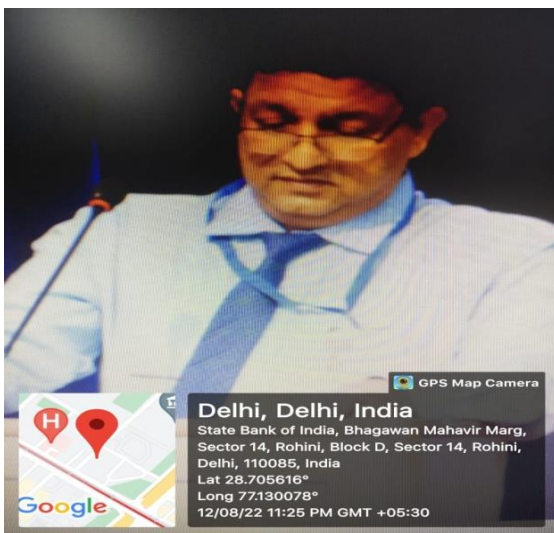

- c. Poster making/ infographics on HIV or Youth

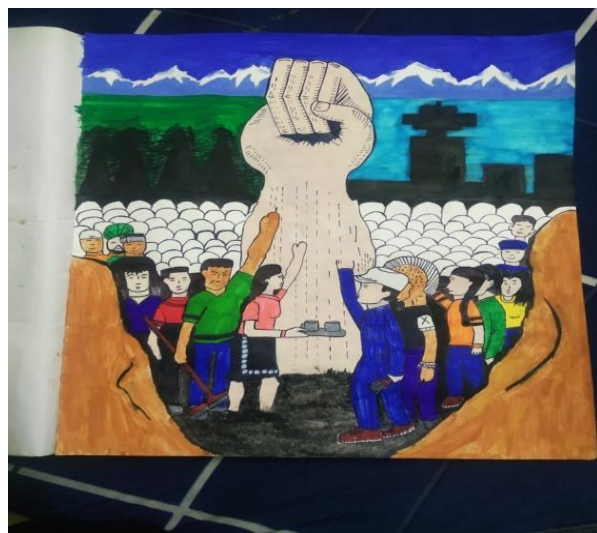

She further said that we should take constructive steps to eliminate chronic diseases for making our planet safe. 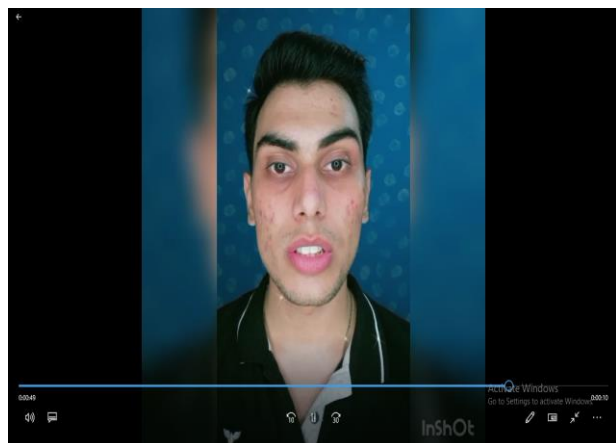
