

# INTRODUCTION

1. "Ek Bharat Shreshta Bharat" (EBSB) Camp JK&L for Cdts of NCC Dte of Delhi and JK&L will be conducted by NCC Gp HQ Jammu under the aegis of NCC Dte JK&L from **11 to 20 Oct 2022 at NCC Camping Ground, Nagrota**. A Strength of 500 Cdts, 10 ANOs and detailed staff will attend EBSB Camp.

# <u>AIM</u>

- 2. The Camp is being organised with a view to achieve the following aims and objectives:-
  - (a) To foster the sprit of National Integration.
  - (b) To create awareness amongst the Cdts of JK&L and Delhi about the respective cultures, religion, heritage, customs and traditions by organizing

talks, discussions and by making them aware by training, living and eating together.

(c) To provide an opportunity to work together and start a process to develop better understanding, harmony and instill nationalistic feeling among Cdts.

#### **SCOPE**

- 3. The scope of EBSB Camp will encompass the following:-
  - (a) Foster the spirit of national integration and solidarity amongst the participating Cdts by providing them an opportunity of community living and working together.
  - (b) Create amongst the participants, an awareness about the geographic variance, divergent cultures, traditions and customs of India and respective UTs/State.
  - (c) Instill in Cdts the values of discipline, integrity and espirit-de-corps.
  - (d) To provide an opportunity to the Cdts to get an insight into each other's UTs/State.
  - (e) To familiarize Cdts with the war like equipment held with the Def Forces and the nuances of Border Management.

#### **GENERAL**

# **Venue**

4. The Camps will be held at NCC Camping Ground Nagrota, located approx 20 Kms from Jammu Tawi Rly Stn and 10 Km from General Bus Stand Jammu.

# <u>Theme</u>

5. The theme of EBSBCamp Jammu -2022 is "Towards a Better Tomorrow: Jammu, Kashmir and Ladakh On the Path of Progress and Development"

# **Duration**

6. Duration of the EBSB Camp will be of 10 daysfrom 11 to 20 Oct 2022.

# **Climate**

7. The climate of Jammu during the month of Oct is moderately cold. Light woolen clothes will be required in the evenings and during trainingvisits.

#### **Strength**

8. The Dte wise strength of participating Cdts, will be as given below for Camp. The Details of ANOs, PI Staff and GCI is att as **Appx A**:-

- 9. <u>Selection of Cdts</u>. The following Points should be kept in mind while selecting the Cdts for EBSB Camp:-
  - (a) Cdts should be talented enough to participate in competitions like quiz, presentations and cultural activities. Quiz Competition shall be conducted to enhance awareness about the UTs of Jammu, Kashmir and Ladakh.
  - (b) Need to be well versed with the Culture, Economy, History and Geography of their respective Region.
  - (c) Cdts should be able to express themselves fluently in Hindi or English.
  - (d) Cdts should not have attended a similar Camp earlier.
- 10. **ANOs.** As per details given at **Appx A**. ANOs as per Appx should accompany the contingent. They should be able to organised presentations of their respective Dtes. Required material like CDs/ Pen Drives on presentations will be carried by the ANO.
- 11. **PIStaff**. Detailment of PI staff is as per **Appx B**. Any addl PI staff accompanying the contingent, will not be accepted.

# **Arrival and Reception**

- 14. The contingents should reach Jammu on 11 Oct 2022 for EBSBCamp.

- 16. <u>ETA.</u> Contingent should intimate their ETA to the a/m appointments by **01 Oct 2022** to facilitate proper reception. It is also pertinent to mention that only **Post-Paid** SIMs of other states will operate/function of all mob service providers beyond LAKAHANPUR (State Border/40Kms from Pathankot). Pre-Paid SIMs other than those obtained at J&K will automatically cease to function beyond Lakhanpur, Participants be briefed accordingly. Train schedule is attached as Appx C.

#### **TRAINING**

#### **Key Activities During The Camp**

- 17. Two Days Training by trainers of EXPA will be organised during the EBSB Camp. The activities which will be incorporated in the camp include :-
  - (a) Learn minimum one folk song/dance.
  - (c) Taste and learn about cuisine and food habits.
  - (d) Wear attire of paired state.
  - (e) Exposure to alphabets songs, proverbs and 10 sentences in the languages of the pairing state.
  - (f) Cadets to learn about the state to include history (particularly war events), cultural heritage, customs and traditions, economy etc. .
  - (g) Educational tours to places of historical and tourist importance.
  - (h) Lectures by Guest Speaker to include induction of NCC cadets into Armed Forces.

# **Competitions**

- 18. The following inter-Dte competitions will be conducted during the camp:-
  - (a) <u>Cultural Competition.</u> It will comprise of four items. In group song and dance a max of 10-20 Cdts can participate from both Dtes. Duration of each event will be max of 6 minutes. In addition, one solo item (dance and song) will be organised. Duration of the solo event will be 4-5 minutes. Musical instruments and props etc, needed will be brought by the performing Dte.
  - (b) <u>NIA Presentation</u>. The presentation will be limited to 30 minutes for each Dte. The ANO accompanying the Cdts will be responsible to organised the presentation. DelhiDte should bring their ppt presentations, costumes and other equipment required for the event. Min of 12 and max of 20 Cdts can participate.
  - (c) **Sports.** Volley ball, Kho-Kho, and Tug of war competitions for SD and SW will also be organised.
  - (d) <u>Painting/Poster Making Competition.</u> Five SD and Five SW Cdts of both Dtes will participate. Topic will be given one day in advance.
  - (e) Essay Writing Competition. Topics will be given one day in advance.

(f) <u>Extempore Speaking.</u> Six SD and Six SW Cdts from both theDtes will participate. Topics will be given on the spot.

## (g) Other Events:

- (i) <u>Display Your Talent.</u>Cdts will be given opportunity to display any special talent.
- (ii) <u>Acquaintance with Traditional Attire.</u>Cdts will have the opportunity to wear the traditional attire of each other's state.

#### **Detailed Programme**

19. The detailed programme will be forwarded by 01 August 2022.

#### Orientation

- 20. It is recommended that Delhi Dte conduct an orientation of Cdts covering following aspects in respect of their State prior to dispatch of contingent for the camp : -
  - (a) Knowledge of Customs, Traditions, History and Cultural Heritage.
  - (b) Knowledge regarding Economic Development of the State and the Country.
  - (c) A general overview of the country's historical, cultural, industrial and economic development.
  - (d) Aim of youth programme and how these contribute towards national integration.
- 21. Some commonly used sentences duly translated in English, Hindi, Kashmiri, and Ladakhi language for ease of understanding of NCC Cdts participants in EBSB Camp are also attached as **Appx D**.

# **Messing**

- 25. A Camp cookhouse will be established for Cdts& ANOs.
- 26. All PI staff attending the Camp will dine in the Camp Cookhouse. They will deposit the requisite amount, in cash, on account of messing, in the Camp Office immediately on arrival and obtain a receipt for it.
- 27. <u>Menu</u>. Menu for the camp will be displayed in the Camp Area Notice Board by the Deputy Camp Comdt.
- 28. Officer-In-Charge (OIC) Catering will supervise the catering services during Camp.

#### **Medical**

- 29. All Cdts and offrs attending the camp should undergo med exam by registered med practitioner/ RMO and should be free from infectious diseases. All cadets should carry their Covid 19 vaccination certificate and masks.
- 30. During the Camp, routine sick report will be attended in the Camp MI Room. Serious cases, if any, will be evacuated to 166 MH at Jammu.

# **Clothing and Equipment**

- 31. List of clothing and equipment recommended to be brought is given at Appx F.
- 32. Washerman and EBR. Will be available at nominal charges.
- 33. **EBSB Badge**. The EBSB badge will be available for a nominal payment of Rs.30/- per badge. Exact requirement for the same should be intimated immediately on arrival by respective ANOs.

# Rank Pay and TA/ DA

34. No Rank pay or TA/DA will be paid to any pers by the Accts Offr except for the pers from NCC Dte JK&L.

# **SECURITY AND DISCP**

# **Security**

35. <u>General</u>. J&K is a sensitive State, therefore, security is of utmost importance. Adequate security cover is being arranged and Delhi Dte contingent are advised to co-operate with the conducting staff and adhere to the security instructions. Strict

action will be initiated against those violating the same and they will be reverted to their units along with the ANO / concerned staff.

- 36. <u>Weapons</u>. Any items like chains, knives, rods which can be used as weapons, will NOT be permitted in the Camp. A search of baggage and pers will be carried out. Anybody violating these instructions will not be permitted to attend EBSB Camp, Jammu.
- 37. Out Pass and Visitor. No out pass will be permitted during the Camp. Visitors, if any, will be restricted to the visitor's room and will not be taken to living areas.
- Out of Bounds. All areas outside the Camp premises are strictly out of bounds for all ranks.

### DISPERSAL

- 39. <u>Valuables / Cash</u>. All participants are advised not to bring any valuables or excess cash to the camp. The Camp authorities will not be responsible for any loss. Extra cash/ valuables, if brought, should be deposited in the Camp Office and receipt for the same be obtained. These will be returned on termination of the Camp.
- 40. Delhi Dte is advised to make their rail reservations for onward and return journey well in advance. The camp will NOT undertake the responsibility for reservations.

# CONCLUSION

- 41. EBSB Camp Jammu 2022 offers a unique opportunity to the Cdts of the Delhi Directorate to have a first hand experience of JK&L. The Camp will give the Participating Cdts an opportunity to get a feel of the life, culture, aspirations and dynamics of the society in Jammu Kashmir & Ladakh as well as Delhi. Co-operation of each ANO, GCI, PI Staff and cadet is solicited to make the EBSB Camp J&K -2022 a grand success and a memorable event.


