REPORT

Sadbhavana day was organized at Tecnia Institute of Advanced through National Service Scheme Unit on 3rd October, 2022. Sadbhavana literally means “Good Feelings” or “Good Will”. The theme of Sadbhavana is to promote National Integration and Communal Harmony among people of all religions, languages and regions.. The idea behind observance of 'Sadbhavana Diwas' is to eschew violence and to promote goodwill among the people. Ceremony may be observed on 3rd October, 2022. The theme is promoted by taking “Sadbhavana Day Pledge”.

SADBHAVANA DAY PLEDGE

“I take this solemn pledge that I will work for the emotional oneness and harmony of all the people of India regardless of caste, Creed, religion, region or language. I further pledge that I shall resolve all differences among us through dialogue and constitutional means without resorting to violence”.

The Communal Harmony Campaign Week was observed as an annual feature from the 19th to 25th November 2015 to coincide with the Qaumi Ekta week. Dean, Director, all department

HODs, Faculty members, students and NSS volunteers participated in this Event. After the pledge NSS Volunteers with Ms Vaishali Prasad, NSS Program officer visited School Sarvodaya Co-ed Vidyalaya, Sector- 8, Rohini. Ms Vaishali Prasad, addressed the officers and staff of the school about the significance of this week and briefed on the aim of observing the event and the noble activities carried out by NSS Cell, Tecnia Institute of Advanced Studies. During the occasion, all were encouraged for voluntary contributions to the National Foundation for Communal Harmony (NFCH). NSS volunteers spread the awareness among students to promote national integration and communal harmony.
