Violation of rules - signal jumps, drunken driving, over-speeding - is also rampant in the city.

As per the statistics compiled by the Research Wing of the Ministry of Road Transport and Highways in its report titled 'Road Accidents in India 2022', Delhi had the highest number of deaths due to road accidents, counting up to 2,300. 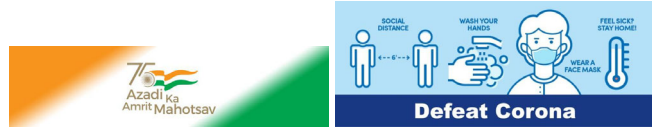
