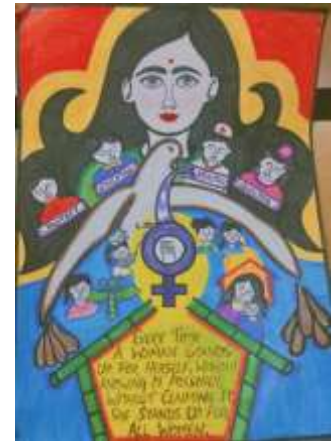
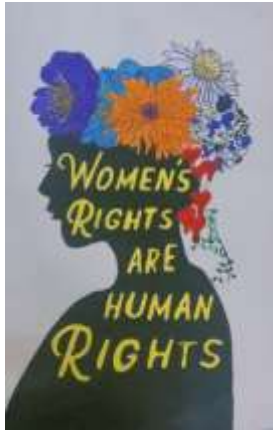
- To assess students' understanding and awareness of women's empowerment
