The Red Ribbon Club organised an Awareness Campaign on HIV-AID'S that was conducted on 29th October 2022 at Bhalswa Dairy Village, Delhi. The program was started by Dr. Sheenu Arora, program officer RRC, TIAS who spoke on the HIV-AIDS and explained its importance. We made a visit to the village where she elaborated the current situation of India in HIV-AIDs cases and how the challenge lies in developing programme to induce behavioural changes among the young as well as the adult population to create the awareness.

People became more aware of the HIV-positive family members and friends nearby as a result. The information regarding this condition can be easily spread among the many social groups in society with the aid of these programmes. With the help of this campaign, we were able to instil a positive outlook on life in HIV-positive patients by teaching them how to manage their medical condition. It informs people of the appropriate contacts to make to obtain the necessary advice in an emergency. The goal of the awareness campaigns was to

inform the public about the kind of test needed to verify your medical condition. We also informed the villagers about all rumours and superstitions about AIDS and HIV.
