HAPPINESS CLUB EVENT REPORT

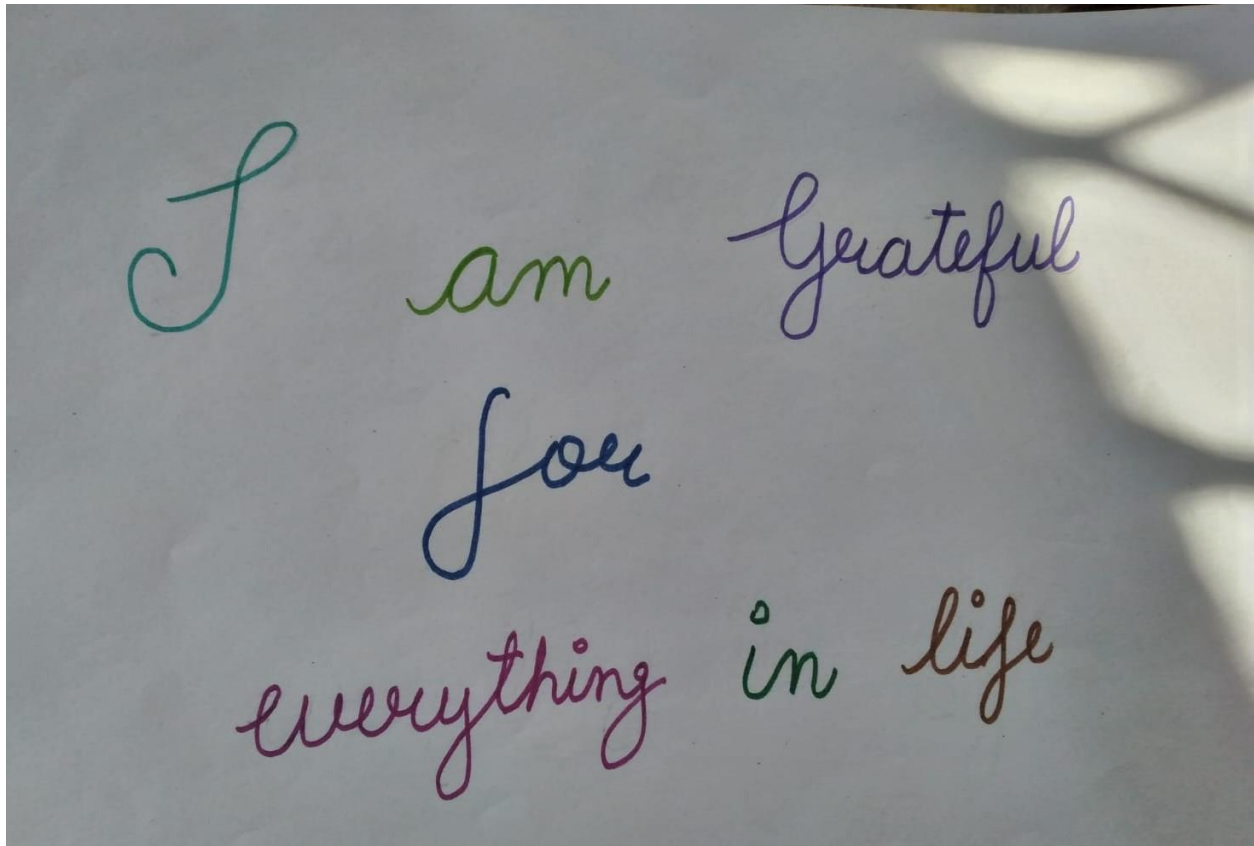
Event : Poster Making Competition on “Affirmation quotes on Positive Thinking”

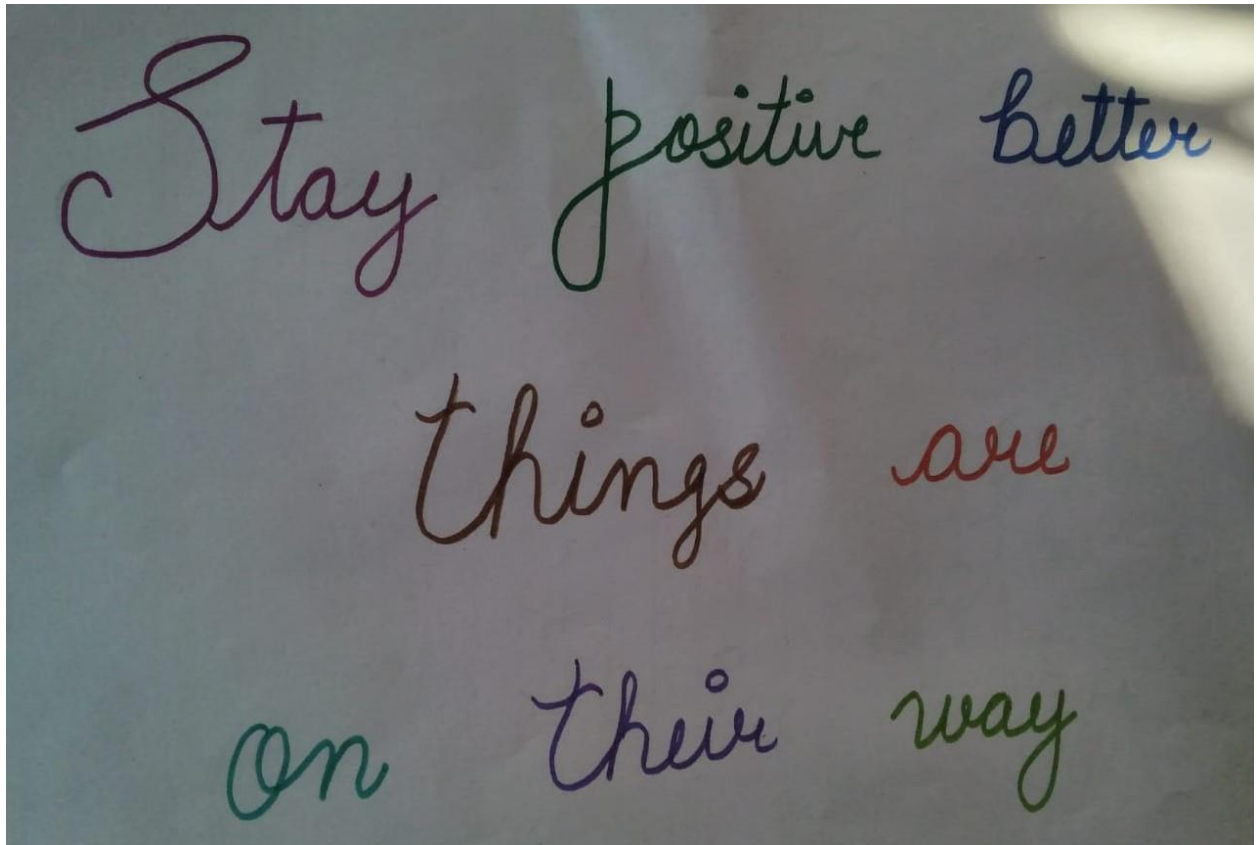
