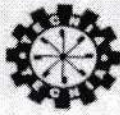

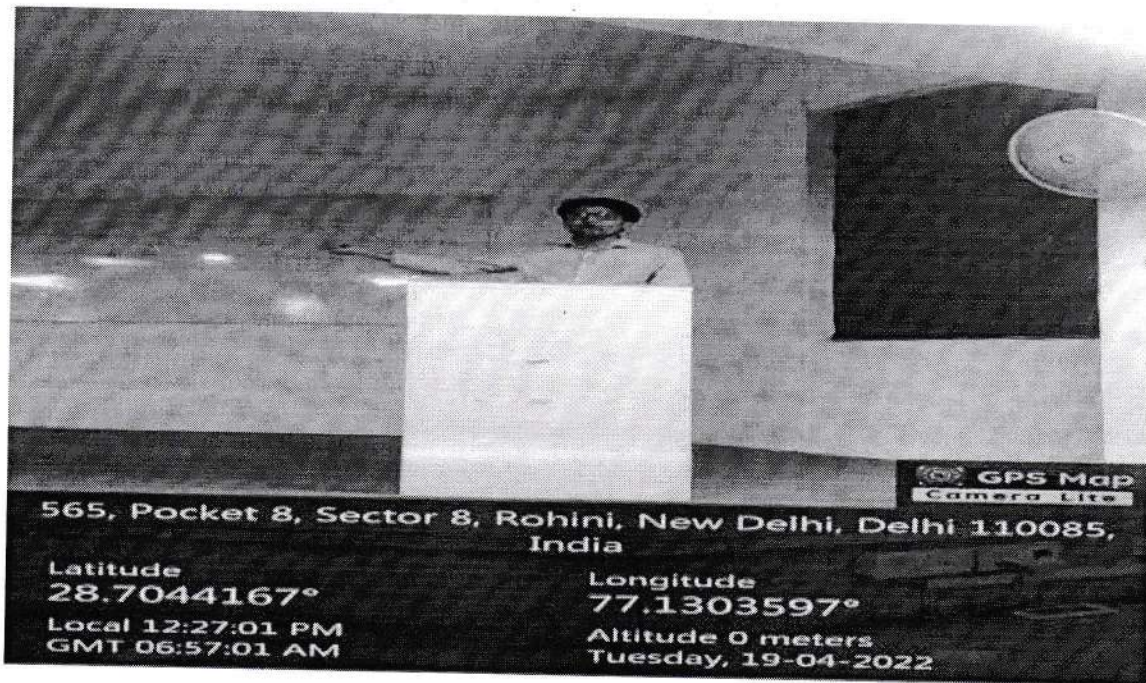


with their point of view on the electoral voting and related topics. Through this contest students are encouraged to participate in this contest and to shine their talent by participating in this contest.

Institute's Eco Clubs plays an important role in creating environmental awareness amongst the future generation. India is a rich cultural country in which various festivals are organized.

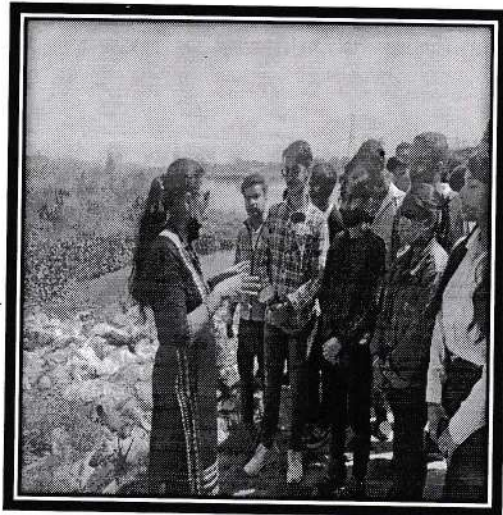
### Awareness Drive on Water pollution at Yamuna River:-
