OBJECTIVES OF THE EVENT:

- To spread the awareness about the Constitution of India.
- To create awareness about the Fundamental Duties and to ensure that every citizen must follow it systematically.
- The main objective is to re unite as as mass movement rather than a government scheme.

REPORT

Every year on November 26th, India celebrates Constitution Day which is also referred to as “Samvidhan Divas,” to mark the adoption of the Indian Constitution. The Constitution of India was enacted by the Constituent Assembly on November 26, 1949, and it became effective on January 26, 1950. The B. R. Ambedkar-written Constitution has been referred to as “first and foremost a social document” by American historian Granville Seward Austin.

Constitution Day is celebrated in Tecnia Institute of Advanced Studies on 26th November, 2022 as a part of celebration of 73rd Anniversary of Adoption of the Constitution of India “SAMVIDHAN DIVAS”. The event commenced at 11:00 am. The programme formally commenced by the warm inaugural session by Ms Vaishali Prasad, NSS Program Officer and Dr Sheenu Arora, NSS Program Coordinator.

Then the welcome address was given by Director Ajay Kumar on Constitution of India. In his address, he said that “The constitution is the foundation of the country's political system under which its people are governed. Constitution of any State legislature, executive and judiciary wings establishes their powers, the demarcation of their obligations and regulates their relations with the public. Infact, each of the ideals of its founders and creators of the Constitution is the mirror of the values and dreams of the people and is based on the specific social, political and economic goals and faith and aspirations of its people. He said that the Indian Constitution is unique, flexible and highly practical. He said, “The Preamble reflects the philosophy as well as fundamental values of Indian Constitution adopted on 26th November, 1949. It clarifies important aspects, viz.(i) the Constitution derives its Authority from the people of India, (ii) it declares India to be sovereign, socialist, secular, democratic and republic country, and (iii) it clarifies that the objectives of the Constitution are Justice, Liberty, Equality and Fraternity.”

Afterwards Dr. Ruchi Srivastava spoke on the meaning of the Preamble and explained the various philosophy of the Constitution through the meaning of Justice, Liberty, Equality and Fraternity. She highlighted the attainment of Fraternity through Liberty and Equality. Every aspect was explained in very simple language and through stories depicting day-to-day happenings. She further said, “basic

tenets of our constitution are “Freedom of Mind” and “Welfare” as key to country’s development. Constitution provides a scientific approach to manage a society. Then Pledge was taken by Director, faculty members, students at Tecnia Institute of Advanced Studies as well as online <https://readpreamble.nic.in/>. Students and faculty members as also participated in Online quiz <https://constitutionquiz.nic.in/> and Poster making competition on the theme “India- a mother of democracy”. In order to mark and acknowledge the contribution of the framers of the Constitution and to aggrivate the people regarding the prominent values, 26th November is celebrated as 'Constitution Day'.

It took around 2 years, 11 months and 17 days to complete the Constitution.

Therefore, National Constitution Day is celebrated on 26 November to commemorate the adoption of the Constitution of India.

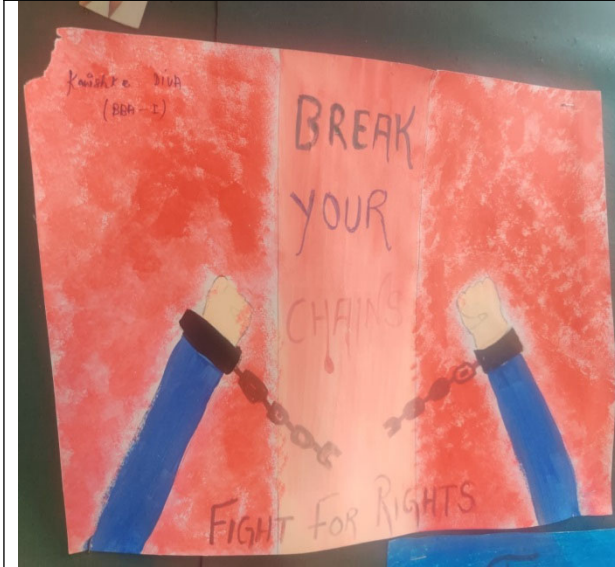
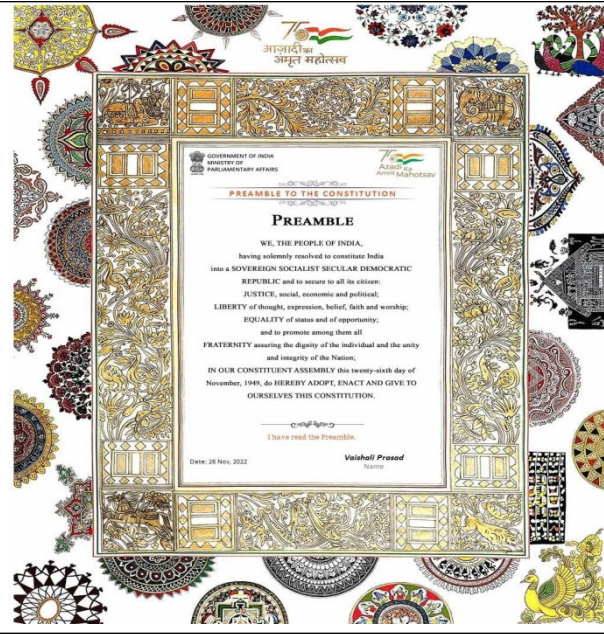
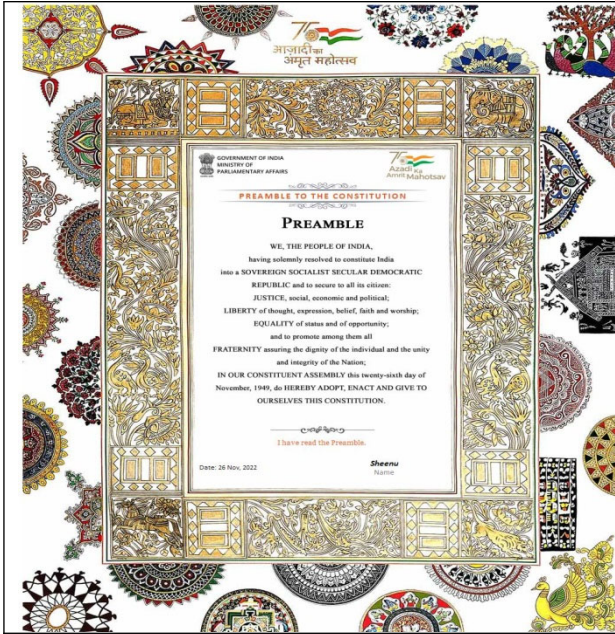
