## **OBJECTIVE**

One of the objectives of World AIDS Day is to create awareness on HIV- AIDS. AIDS (Acquired Immune Deficiency Syndrome) is a medical condition caused by HIV (Human Immunodeficiency Virus) that sabotages the immune system of a person making it vulnerable to infections including opportunistic infections. HIV can be transmitted in many ways such as, use of contaminated syringe or drug equipment, blood transfusion from an infected person and from mother to child during giving birth or breast feeding.

## **REPORT**

The RRC of Tecnia Institute of Advanced Studies, Rohini organized World AIDS Day on 1<sup>st</sup> December, 2022. The programme started at 11:00 AM with the inaugural speech of Dr. Ajay Kumar, Director, TIAS who stated the importance of this celebration and observation of this day. He addressed the students and gave a very relevant speech on AIDS, HIV and causes of them, symptoms and ways to cure them. His speech included various ways how a youth can protect the society through awareness and prevention. The positive sign was the students' including the NSS Volunteers concentration and eagerness towards the problems caused by AIDS by demonstrating placards in regard to stay safe from this deadly disease. Slogan writing/Poster making competition was also organized in which the students prepared descriptive posters. Laksh Kaushik achieved first prize in poster making competition. During the event, students from all streams made posters, slogans depicting the importance of AIDS awareness. Students through the help of posters and slogans highlighted the causes and prevention of this disease and also gave a message to stop all kinds of prejudices associated with AIDS so that a patient suffering from this virus should not feel outcast but should be consider as a respectable member of the society.

Ms. Vaishali Prasad, program officer NSS, TIAS who spoke on the HIV-AIDS and explained its importance. She elaborated the current situation of India in HIV-AIDs cases and how the challenge lies in developing programme to induce behavioural changes among the young as well as the adult population to create the awareness. Dr. Sheenu Arora, program officer RRC, TIAS highlighted the fact that the world is facing new virus each day. She further said that “we all should take constructive steps to eliminate chronic diseases for making our planet safe and

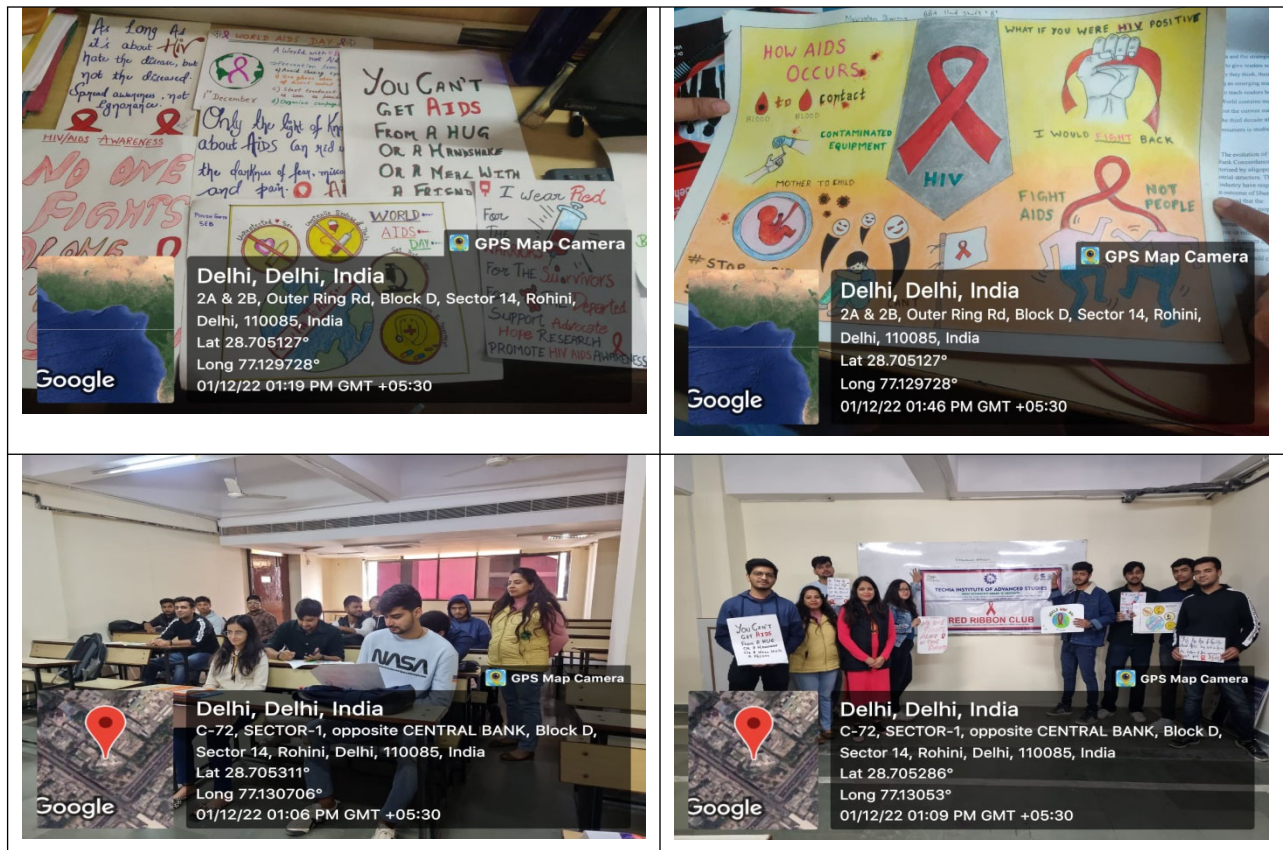
spreading awareness about AIDS disease in communities is must, which our NSS unit volunteers are doing to a great extent.”

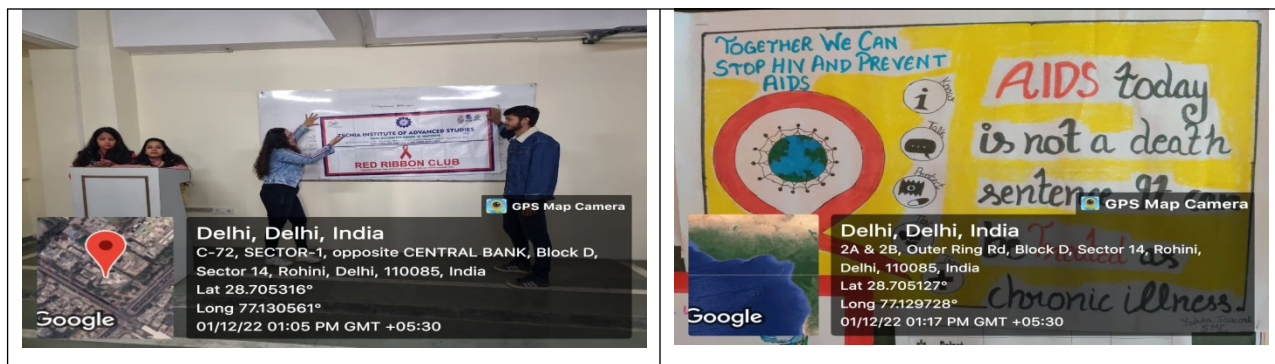
