- Sense of duty among citizens.



PARICHARCHA: A DRAFT PROPOSAL

Background

Yuva Samvad-India@2047 was held at the national level by the Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports on 12th August, 2022 as part of the International Youth Day celebrations at Akashvani Bhavan, New Delhi. During the program, Hon'ble Minister, Youth Affairs and Sports declared that similar events shall be conducted across the nation so as to enable the voice of the youth to be heard for shared dreams and visions for the country as it moves from Amrit Mahotsav towards Amrit Kaal. Carrying forward his vision, the Department of Youth Affairs plans to conduct Yuva Samvad- India @ 2047 at universities across the country.

The Hon'ble Prime Minister has gifted the Panch Pran to the nation during his Independence Day Speech on 15th August, 2022. These Prans shall play a vital role in ensuring the vision of Bharat as Vishwaguru in 2047. Hence it is essential for the youth to understand and adopt the Panch Pran in the age of Amrit Kaal. The Panch Pran are:

1. Goal of developed India
2. Remove any trace of slavery or colonial mindset
3. Take pride in our heritage and legacy
4. unity and solidarity
5. sense of duty among citizens.

In order to popularize the same among the youth of the country it is proposed that NSS along with Ministry of Education organize Yuva Samvaad- India@2047 on the theme "India's Panch Pran- A Youth Dialogue-Bharat Ke Panch Pran- Ek Yuva Paricharcha" in universities across the country.

The Proposed Program

The participants at the Yuva Samvaad shall speak on various topics of National Importance in the broad backdrop of the theme India@2047 and in line with of Panch Prans (five resolves) given by the Hon'ble Prime Minister during his Independence Day Speech from the ramparts of Red Fort on August 15, 2022.

The platform will enable them to connect with each other and participate in building a collective vision for the country's future.

The program shall be organized at university level. Selected **30 Youth** would articulate their vision and dreams. Participation for this programme will be from the youth belonging to age group 18-22 years from each university.

The program shall have the following sessions-

1. Inaugural Session
2. Session 1- Expert Talk on Panch Pran
3. Session 2- Yuva Vichar Manch where the shortlisted 30 speakers shall place their vision before the panel of judges and audience.
4. Session-3 Yuva Samvad where the winners speak before the VIPs followed by participant interaction with Youth Icons and open house discussion.

Particulars of the Program

Format : Town hall format

Resource Persons: 5 (1 Subject Expert and 1 Moderator and 3 judges to select best speakers)

Total Participants: 1000 Youth of Colleges/Universities

Coverage : All Universities of the country.

Foot Notes:

- The winners from among the speakers shall be identified through a committee consisting of 3 luminaries- Prominent University Alumni, NSS/Youth Awardees of last 8 years and local Youth Icons.
- Central/State Ministers, MPs/MLAs shall be requested to grace the second session of the program providing enough time to interact with the youth and participate in the open discussion session.
- The selected 3 winners from among the speakers shall be given a certificate signed by the Hon'ble Minister of Youth Affairs & Sports. All speakers of the event shall be presented with the book- Modi@20 Dreams meet Delivery.
- The outcome of each of the dialogue shall be compiled in a book. The copy of the same with relevant points shall be sent to the concerned Ministries /Departments/ Organizations to bring government closer to the aspirations of the youth of the country.
- Videos with bytes of VIPs and participants shall be recorded on the achievements of the government highlighted during the program, salient points raised during discussion and dreams & aspirations of the youth. This shall be compiled at the Ministry level.
- Ministry of Education shall be roped in as organization partner for this mega event and venue and participants shall be identified by the Ministry of Education in all universities.
- NSS units of identified Universities shall take lead in organization of the proposed program.
