### **Decorate tree with small red ribbons and hang few cards/notes.**

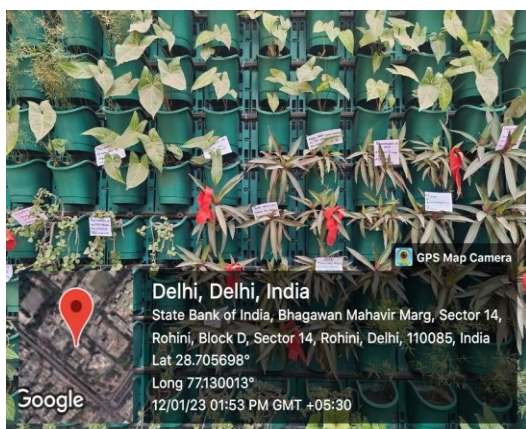
There is only one way to fight the spread of AIDS and that is through creating awareness. Ignorance of is the causes and methods of transfer of HIV and it only makes a bad situation fully
