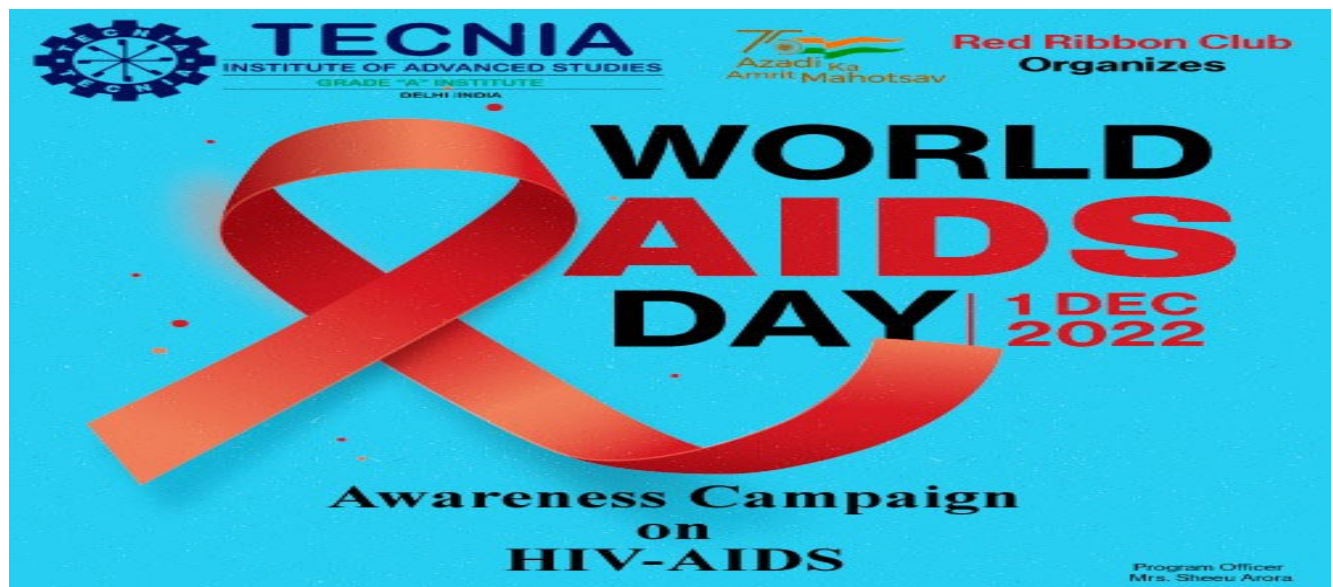

## OBJECTIVE

One of the objectives of World AIDS Day is to create awareness on HIV- AIDS. AIDS (Acquired Immune Deficiency Syndrome) is a medical condition caused by HIV (Human Immunodeficiency Virus) that sabotages the immune system of a person making it vulnerable to infections including opportunistic infections. HIV can be transmitted in many ways such as, use of contaminated syringe or drug equipment, blood transfusion from an infected person and from mother to child during giving birth or breast feeding.

## **REPORT**

The RRC of Tecnia Institute of Advanced Studies, Rohini organized World AIDS Day on 1<sup>st</sup> December, 2022. The programme started at 11:00 AM with the inaugural speech of Dr. Ajay Kumar, Director, TIAS who stated the importance of this celebration and observation of this day. Students through the help of posters and slogans highlighted the causes and prevention of this disease and also gave a message to stop all kinds of prejudices associated with AIDS so that a patient suffering from this virus should not feel outcast but should be consider as a respectable member of the society.

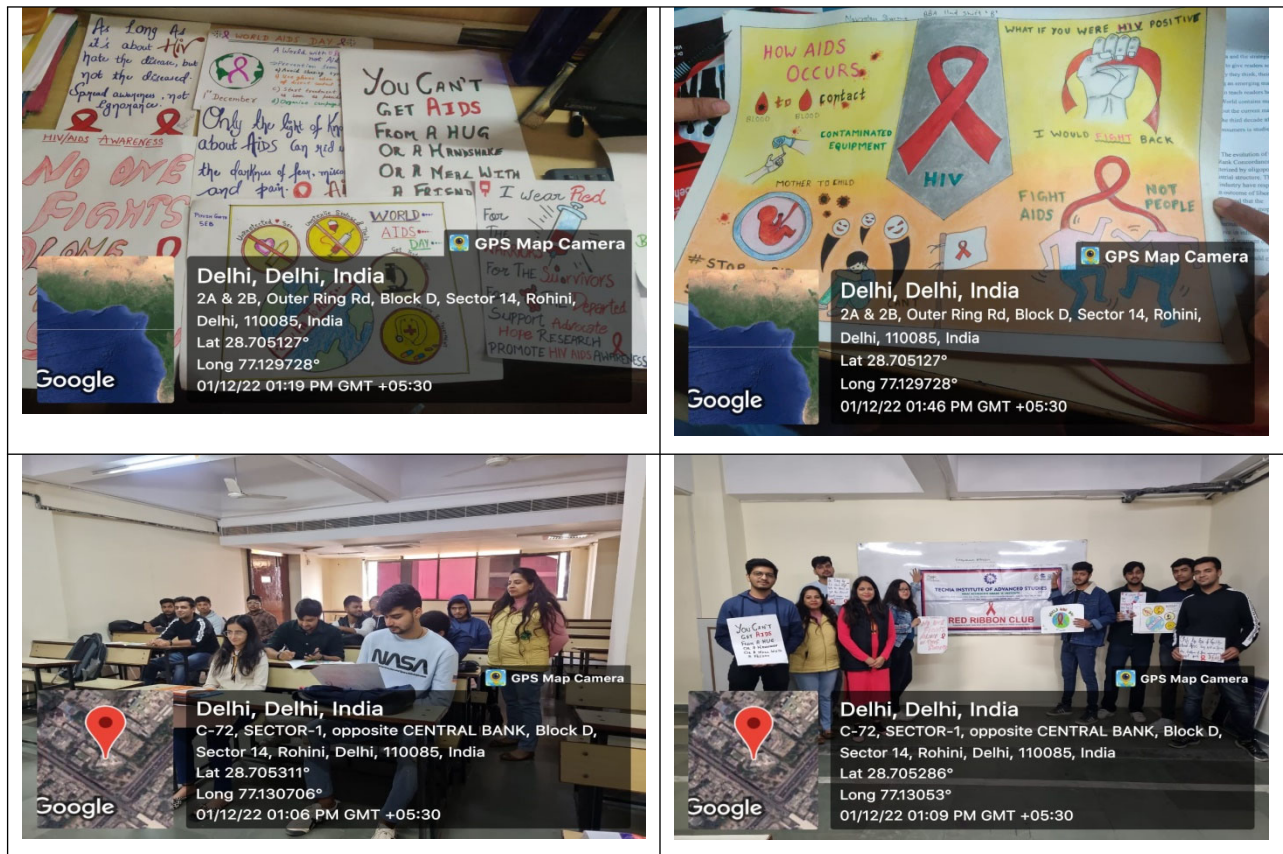

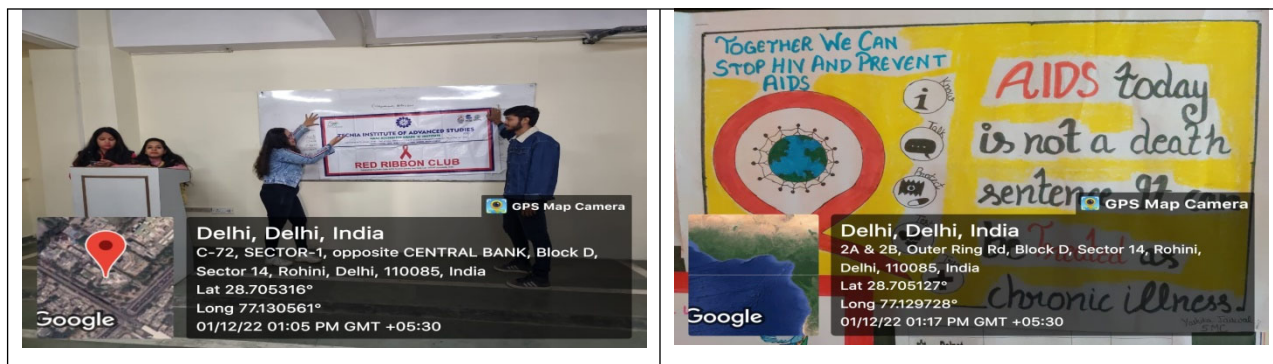
