- 2. Reduce the vulnerability of special category of young women and migrants
- 3. To reduce sigma & discrimination against PLHIVs by mainstreaming.
- 4. To enhance the capacity of policy planners, researchers and trainers in the institutions
- 5. Conceptualizing and planning special projects for youth

#### **Agenda 2: Actions at levels of Departments**

- 1. Identifying Nodal Officer/Officers form every department to implement HIV awareness activities.
- 2. Calendar to organize of awareness activities:
  - a. Competitive activities: Poster making, Slogan writing, Reel making, Skits, Dramatics, Nail

Art, Face painting, Debate, Quiz.

- b. Non-competitive activities: Talk, Seminar, Workshop, Rally, Sports event, promotion on twitter, YouTube, whatsapp, website, magazine, Telegram, Facebook, Instagram etc.
