1. Campaign across all the districts of the country

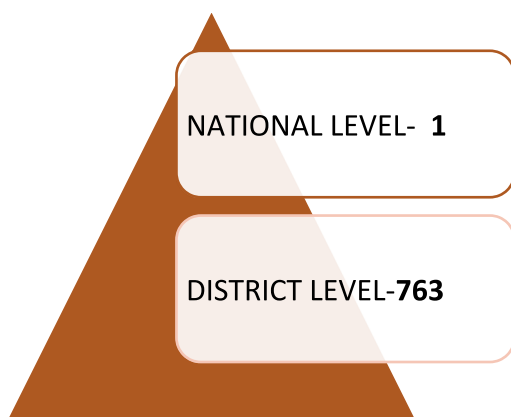

2. Mega Event during 8th and 9th August

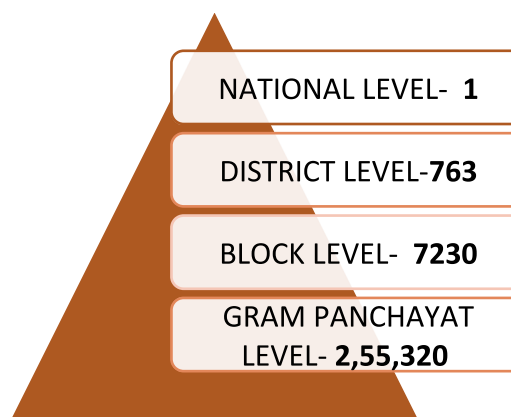
- Creation of statue of Swami Vivekananda at Delhi with representative soil & water samples from across the country.

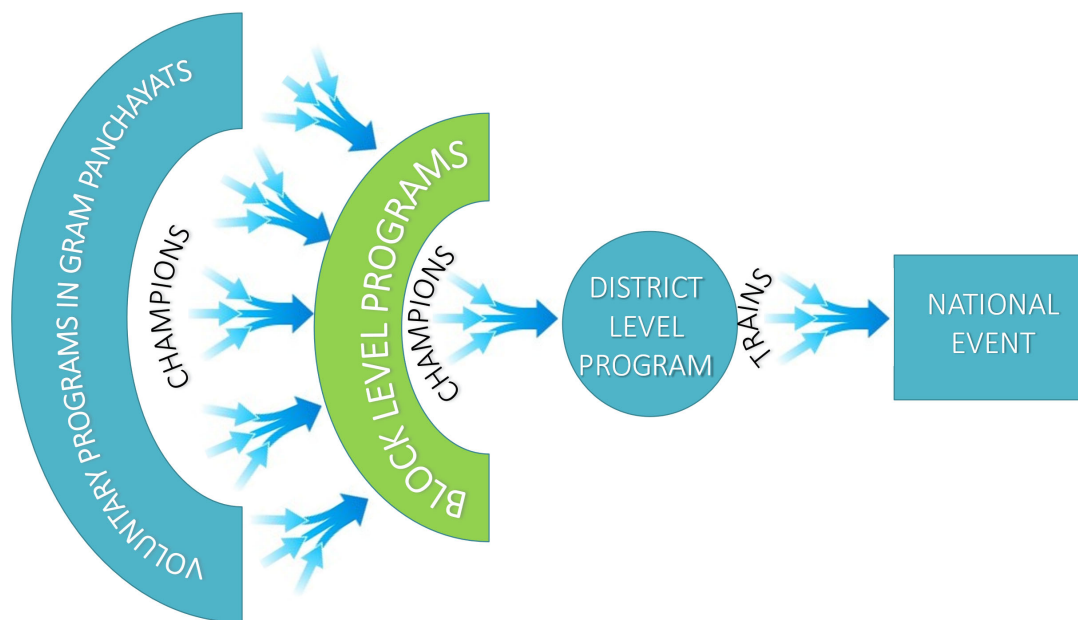

PROGRAM SEQUENCE AND DETAILS

1. PROGRAMS UP TO DISTRICT LEVEL

Commissioning of containers and Bottles for soil & water collection by the DYO shall be done before the beginning of the program at the district level. Identification Of 2 Champions (NYVs, willing Youth Awardees, Award winning Club representatives etc.) per Block to collect soil & water from all Gram Panchayats of the Districts shall be done according to the local situation.



a. Gram Panchayat Level Program

- The Champions identified shall visit all the Gram Panchayat Offices and apprise the Pradhans on the program.
- Under the leadership of the Gram Panchayats Pradhans, site for collection of water and soil may be identified.
- A Gram Panchayat level meeting with the soil and water samples may be held where by the local heroes of freedom struggle, martyrs etc may be remembered along with the history of freedom struggle in the village.
- During the program oath on Panch Pran will also be administered among the participants.

b. Block Level Program

- Representatives of all Gram Panchayats in the Block shall participate in the block level program, carrying with them samples of soil and water from their respective Panchayats.
- The soil & water brought from all the panchayat shall be collected and representative sample of the Block shall be handed over to the Champions during the function.
- The program shall have a session to share the stories of Unsung heroes of freedom struggle and martyrs from the block
- Sapling plantation using the left over soil samples may be undertaken in remembrance of the sacrifices made by the freedom fighters and martyrs.

- Panch Pran Pledge shall be administered to the participants at the program.

c. District Level Program

- All the block level champions shall carry the soil and water samples from the blocks to the district program
- The soil & water brought from all the blocks shall be consolidated at district level program.
- From the mixed sample of the district, Plantation of Unity Tree shall be done to celebrate the unity in diversity of the country- preferably a plant that is native to the district/state tree of the state. (NYKS will coordinate with the District Administration/Forest Deptt. in this regard)
- Panch Pran Pledge shall be administered to the participants at the program.

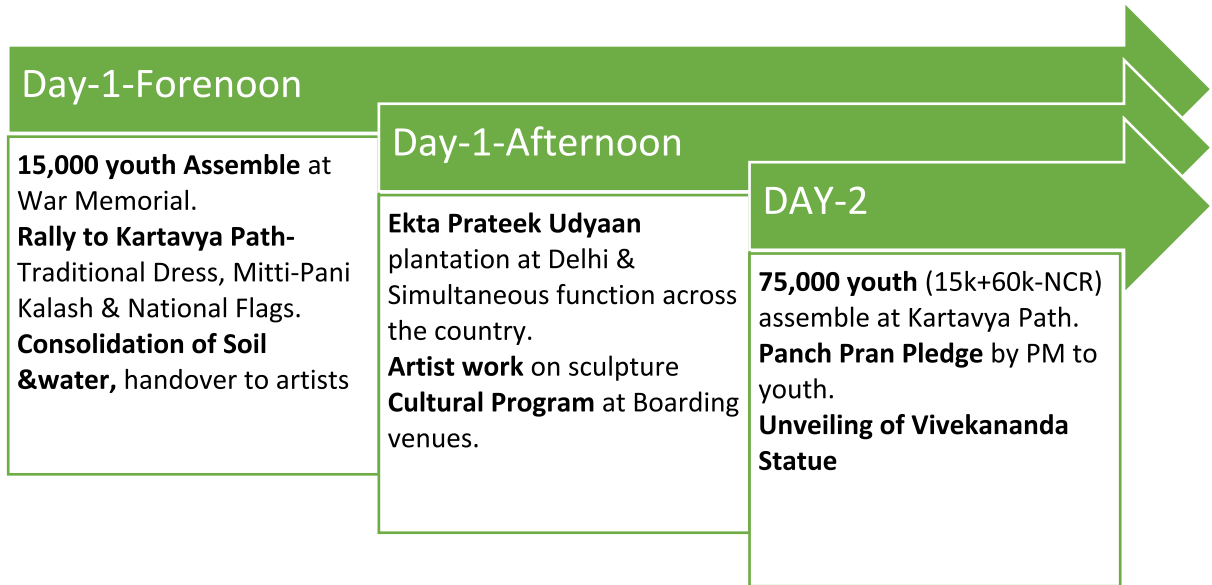
