

The objectives of the day is


1. To promote national harmony, mitigate terrorism, and unity among people of all caste, creed, and sex.

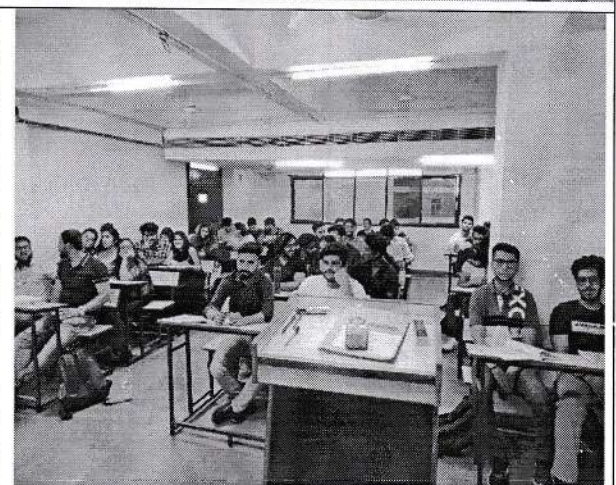
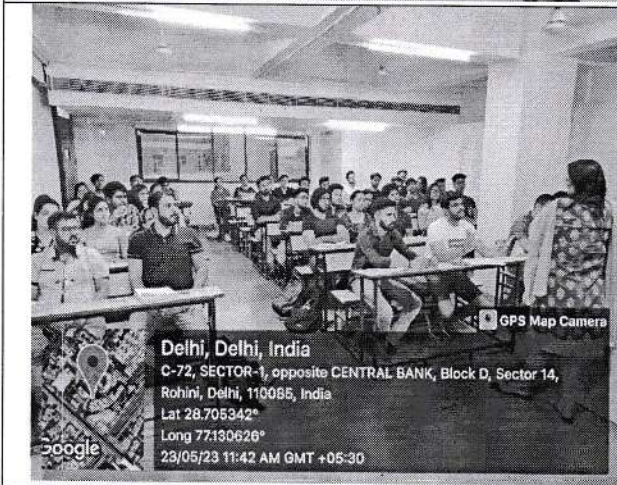
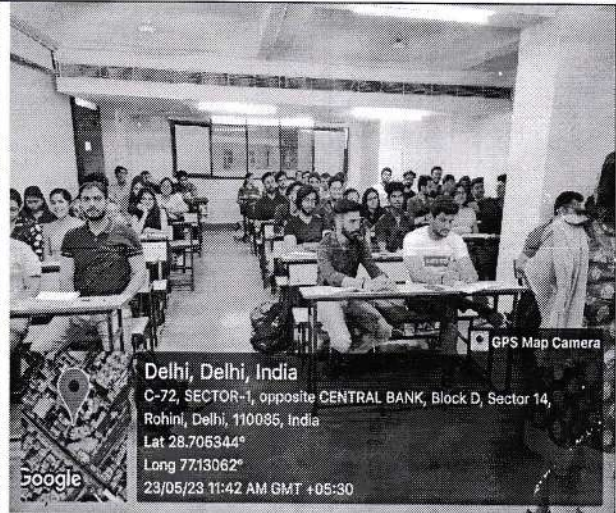
