DSACS essentially plays the role of a mentor along with In charge of the Club for students at college level. Students shall be free to contact DSACS on any issue and their queries shall be answered by experts arranged by DSACS.

Activities by RRC: These RRCs in colleges are encouraged to organize activities pertaining to HIV awareness such awareness sessions on HIV/AIDS, Quiz competitions, Debate competitions Seminar, Workshop, Drama/Street Play competitions, student rallies, activities in College Fest, developing, Poster Making /painting competitions and displaying graphics on HIV/AIDS awareness, organizing Voluntary Blood Donation camps and displaying related educational material in college/institution, promoting life skills, adventure sports activities, creativity, healthy lifestyle and other youth based interactive programmes at college level.

The actual success of the interaction largely depends upon the commitment of the college and students. You are requested to kindly designate one mentor (may be senior teacher e.g. NSS in charge) and accept the responsibility of being the patron of the RRC of your college. We would require a list of about 10-15 volunteers, as club members, including two club coordinators.

Financial support provided by DSACS for establishing a new RRC shall be Rs. 9000 in the first year and Rs.4000 annually thereafter. This fund is transferred in the name of the college. This budget may be spent on the activities to be undertaken by the Club and an Utilization Certificate (UC) with details of expenditure and a brief report on activities undertaken shall be required to be submitted by the College at the end of year.

Your support in reaching out to the young citizens is invaluable. You are requested to kindly take up the matter personally so that the minimum activities and the schedule of activities may commence early. These clubs may be made functional by organizing a Voluntary Blood Donation Camp in college for which due support will be provided by DSACS.
