[4.4], "Value-based education will include the development of humanistic, ethical, Constitutional, and universal human values of truth (Satya), righteous conduct (dharma), peace (shanti), love (prem), nonviolence (ahimsa), scientific temper, citizenship values, and also life-skills; lessons in seva/service and participation in community service programs will be considered an integral part of a holistic education" [11.8]

ⁱⁱ 1. Each college must prepare at least 1 faculty mentor for every 20 newly joined students. Faculty must be prepared from every department/ branch/ discipline (by attending an introductory UHV FDP)
2. Each college must prepare at least 1 UHV-I faculty for every 60 newly joined students. Faculty must be prepared from every department/ branch/ discipline (by attending a UHV-I or UHV-II FDP)
3. Each college must prepare at least 1 UHV-II faculty for every 120 newly joined students. Faculty must be prepared from every department/ branch/ discipline (by attending a UHV-II FDP)
