Report:



Humayun's Tomb is rich in intricate details and textures, offering a multitude of opportunities for close-up shots. They focused on capturing the delicate carvings, ornate patterns, and calligraphy on the walls and ceilings. By employing macro photography techniques, they highlighted the fine craftsmanship and brought attention to the minute details that often go unnoticed.

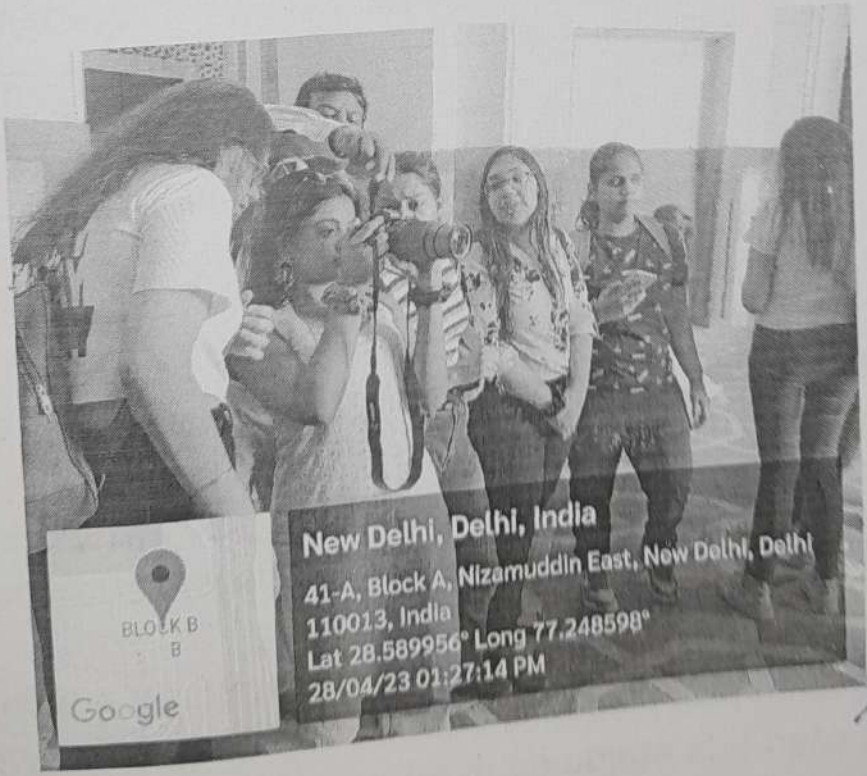
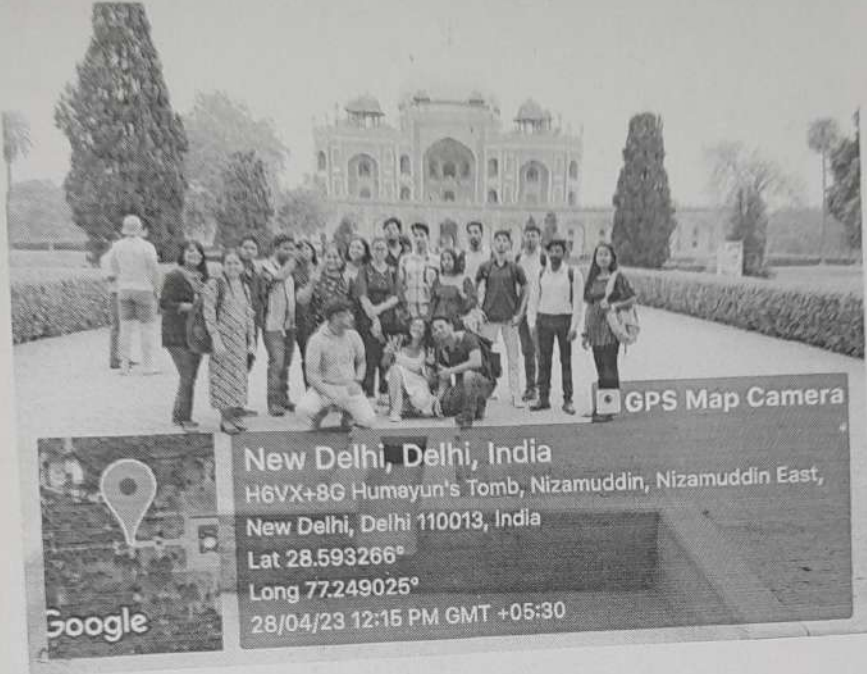


