

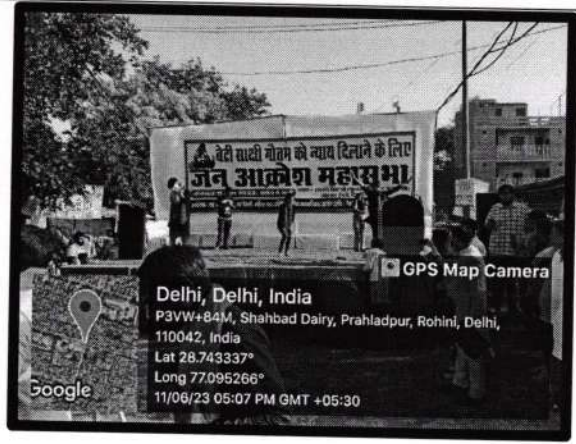
**Report - Street Play on 'Women Tolerance- Sakshi'**


**Report**
