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SOP for Drama Competition during Youth Fest 2023-24

BACKGROUND: As per National Family Health Survey 5, Comprehensive Knowledge of HIV/AIDS among adults (15-49 years) in India is 21.6% for women and 30.7% for men. There is urgent need to improve and increase Comprehensive Knowledge of HIV/AIDS through various activities across the country, especially amongst young people.

Rationale

Folk performance by Red Ribbon Clubs will be popular method of promoting awareness about HIV and AIDS among youth. These RRCs will use traditional folk art forms such as Street Play and skits to aware their peers about HIV and AIDS. The performances often include information on HIV/AIDS and the services provided by the National AIDS Control Organization (NACO) and the State AIDS Control Societies (SACS) as well as the importance of AIDS helpline 1097.

Aims and Objectives-

- Create awareness among maximum youth/ RRC students
- To reduce new HIV infection among youth
- Awareness on Sex, Sexuality and HIV/AIDS
- To reduce myth and misconception among youth on HIV/AIDS
- Support people living with HIV/AIDS (PLWHA) thereby reducing stigma and discrimination against PLHAs
- Reduce hesitation and increase acceptance

TARGET GROUP: Youth 17-25 years

Participation criteria

- Students from only colleges/institutes having RRCs will participate
- 1st and 2nd year students of college/institute will participate, however, higher classes students may be involved as mentors
- Minimum 7-10 RRC colleges/institutes should participate in District level for which colleges/institutes may be selected by SACS

The prizes for State level will be given only after participation of concerned team in regional level. If winning team will not participate at regional level, then the second team will be declared as a state winner
- Script will be finalized by college/ SACS
- SACS will submit the final script in English to the SACS / NACO who are organizing regional level competition maximum 1 month prior to the competition.
- Teams will record the videos of their performances and submit to SACS for further use. SACS will prepare short clips of performances with key messages and may use these videos for social media.

National Level Competition

- Winner of each regional will be called for participation in National level. In case winner is not able to participate then second team may be called.
- Script will be finalized by SACS
- SACS will submit the final script in English to NACO maximum 1 month prior to the national event.
- Teams will record the videos of their performances and submit to SACS for further use. SACS will prepare short clips of performances with key messages and may use these videos for social media.

Distribution of Prize Money- SACS will disburse the Prize money to the teams only after completion of outreach activities plan .

Outreach activity plan of District, State , Regional and National Level

- **District Level** -After completion of District level competition Top 3 teams will do minimum 2 performances in nearby college/school, markets, bus stands, railway stations, tourist place, NSS/NCC camp, local fair & festivals, District/State events of SACS or as decided by SACS or District Health Authority. A declaration will be taken from each team regarding outreach performances prior to district level competition. Teams are not willing to sign the declaration will be disqualified.

- **State level** - After completion of State level competition Top 3 teams will do minimum 2 performances in nearby college/school, markets, bus stands, railway stations, tourist place, NSS/NCC camp, local fair & festivals, District/State events of SACS or as decided by SACS. A declaration will be taken from each team regarding outreach performances prior to district level competition. Teams are not willing to sign the declaration will be disqualified.
- **Outreach plan at regional level** - After completion of Regional each teams will do minimum 5 performances in their state in nearby college/school, markets, bus stands, railway stations, tourist place, NSS/NCC camp, local fair & festivals, District/State events of SACS or as decided by SACS. A declaration will be taken from each team regarding outreach performances prior to district level competition. Teams are not willing to sign the declaration will be disqualified.
- **National level-** All teams will perform at least 7 performances in their state in nearby college/school, markets, bus stands, railway stations, tourist place, NSS/NCC camp, local fair & festivals, District/State events of SACS or as decided by SACS. A declaration will be taken from each team regarding outreach performances prior to district level competition. Teams are not willing to sign the declaration will be disqualified.

SOP for MARATHON during Youth Fest 2023-24

BACKGROUND: As per National Family Health Survey 5, Comprehensive Knowledge of HIV/AIDS among adults (15-49 years) in India is 21.6% for women and 30.7% for men. There is urgent need to improve and increase Comprehensive Knowledge of HIV/AIDS through various activities across the country, especially amongst young people.

RATIONAL: It is important to actively engage the youth in healthy lifestyle and physical activities so that they can maintain healthy living and keeping themselves free from not just lifestyle diseases but also to keep themselves free from behaviors which put them at risk of getting infected with HIV and other STIs.

AIMS & OBJECTIVES:

1. *Greater visibility for the issue of HIV/AIDS and drug abuse*
2. *Encourage safe and responsible sexual behaviour amongst the youth*
3. *Promote HIV/AIDS & STI related services.*
4. *Increase basic knowledge about HIV/AIDS.*

TARGET GROUP: Youth 17-25 years (College Students / Red Ribbon Club members)

EXPECTED OUTCOME:

1. Increase in Comprehensive Knowledge of HIV/AIDS

SOPs for School Quiz competition

Background:

Adolescents and Youth represents the one third of the Indian population. Approximately 40 Crore population belongs to youth category. Since the adolescent and youth population is *at risk*, the idea is to educate the Youth (13-17 years) about the HIV/AIDS and STI/RTI. The students from 8th, 9th and 11th standard from Govt., Govt. Aided and Private will participate in the school level quiz competition, District, State, Regional and National level quiz competition.

Rationale:

Due to the present scenario and the influence of social media among the adolescents and youth due attention, awareness and sensitization shall be provided to the youth on HIV/AIDS and Healthy life style in the mode of Quiz Competitions at the Schools, Districts, State, Regional and National levels

The objectives of these competitions are as below:

- To provide comprehensive knowledge on HIV/AIDS and STI/RTI.
- By Providing interactive platform for information exchange on issues related to Health & Well being
- To remove Social Taboos & myths
- To discuss reproductive Health issues
- To provide knowledge on diet & nutrition, Sanitation and hygiene.
- To reduce stigma and discrimination.

Name of the Event - 'Red Ribbon Quiz Competition'

Target Group: Students covering 8th, 9th and 11th standard.

Expected Outcome: Increase in Comprehensive knowledge on HIV/ AIDS, STI and RTI and Healthy life style.

Pre- Publicity - Print Media, social media, Electronic Media (Radio, TV channel, SMS), Banners/Hoardings. Publicity of the event should start at least one month before of the event for smooth process of registration of entries.

Timeline:

School level: by 10th September 2023

District Level – 10th – 15th September 2023

State Level: September – 20th September 2023

Regional Level: November – December 2023

National Level: 12th January, 2024

All the SACS are requested to complete the State level competition on or before September last week.

Implementation Plan:

School level-

DAPCU/DACO in association with Department of Education will organize school level quiz competition for students of class 8th, 9th and 11th standard for identify the team, the team will consist two participants . A standard questionpaper will be prepared by SACS covering the following topics -General Health, Adolescents Health including menstrual hygiene, healthy diet, etc., HIV/AIDS basics, Voluntary Blood. Donation and other state and national health programs, etc.

The top scoring 10 teams will be qualified for district level quiz competition. The school level winners will be awarded the digital/online certificate. The director of education shall carry all the activity to identify 10 team for district level quiz.

District level

The district level quiz competition will be organized by DAPCU/DACO and Education Department. A SACS representative will be coordinating the district level quiz competition. SACS will prepare the questions covering General Health, Adolescent Health including menstrual hygiene, healthy diet, HIV/AIDS, Voluntary Blood. Donation, Govt Health Programs etc.

State Level

The district level winner team will compete in state level quiz competition. The SACS will directly organize the program on physical mode.

Regional Level

One team along with nodal teacher and SACS official will participate in the regional quiz competition. The refreshment, prize money, mementos, certificate venue arrangements, etc will be arranged by the hosting SACS. In each region, 8 -9 SACS will participate. The questions will be finalized by hosting SACS in consultation with NACO.

National Level

The National Level quiz competition will be tentatively on 12th January ie, National Youth Day. Regional winners will participate in National Quiz competition.

Budgeting

SACS will be required to plan & meet expenses on the above activities from Youth Fest approved under Annual Action Plan.

Monitoring & reporting:

Monitoring will be conducted by SACS officials in collaboration with respective District Sports Officers, DACOs, RRC Coordinators and CMOs.

- District level committee consist of DNO/DTHO/RRC Coordinator/Nodal Officers, Representative of NYK/NSS/NCC & sports & youth welfare department.

Standard Operating Procedures –

- SACS will create a registration link itself or through any voluntary organization or they may hire a technical agency if required.
- SACS may request college to nominate minimum 20 to maximum 50 entries through registration link provided by SACS to colleges.
- District committee will decide best 3 out of total entries received from all the colleges.
- 03 best entries selected from districts will be forwarded to state.
- Selection criteria will be based on content, animation, correct information in appropriate language.

Timeline-

- State – 28th September 2023
- Regional -November/ December 2023
- National- January 2024

Duration - Reels will be from 30 secs- 1min maximum.

Theme-

- Routes of transmission,
- Stigma & Discrimination,

- Promotion of HIV testing.

Pre & post promotional activity –

Through social media, private FM, Colleges social media handles, Posters in college notice board area. Publicity of the event should start at least one month before of the event for smooth process of registration of entries.

Coverage-

The participation will be open at district level. SACS may cover NSS, NYK, Govt Colleges, Technical Education Institutions, and Leading Universities.

Budgeting

SACS will be required to plan & meet expenses on the above activities from Youth Fest approved under Annual Action Plan.

Monitoring & Reporting-

SACS will be responsible for overall monitoring and documentation of the activity. The program is to be organized at college, district and state level. SACS may take help of RRC Nodal, district officials.

Minutes of the meeting

Minutes of the meeting of State Level Committee for activities for Youth Festival 2023 in Delhi under the chairmanship of Additional Project Director, DSACS on 17.08.2023 at DSACS

1. A meeting of State Level Committee for the activities for Youth Festival in Delhi was held under the Chairmanship of Additional Project Director, Delhi State AIDS Control Society on 17.08.2023 at 11.00 A.M. in Conference Hall, Delhi State AIDS Control Society Dharmshala Block, Dr. BSA Hospital, Rohini, Sector-6, and Delhi-110085. The list of participants is at annexure 1. It was noticed that no representation from Directorate of Education & Directorate of Higher Education, GNCTD.
2. The meeting was briefed about the activities as part of Youth Festival 2023 in Delhi and role of the institutions/ departments. Assistant Director (Youth Director), DSACS presented the activities to be conducted in Youth Festival 2023 viz. Red Run, Drama, Reel making and Quiz Competition.
3. **Red Run**
 - i. It was informed that run of 5 Km will be organized in one of the stadiums in Delhi. AD (YA) may co-ordinate with Chhatarsal Stadium as the run venue by next week. It was discussed that the run shall be organized in morning. Age criteria for the Run will above 18years of age till 25 years.
Action: AD(YA)
 - ii. 1 male and 1 female student nominated from each Red Ribbon Club will be accepted. Communication in this regard has been sent to all concerned by AD(Youth Affairs). The nomination may be collected latest by last week of August. Beside consent shall also be obtained for allowing participation.
Action: All Red Ribbon Club, AD (YA)
 - iii. One medical team shall be required at the time of the run in the stadium. CDMO of the north district shall be requested to kindly arrange the medical team and the medical kits. Ambulance services for the event may be requested to CATS. Letter shall be sent to CATS in this regard.
Action: CDMO North, AD (YA)
 - iv. Team arrangement for time keeping, tracking the winner, runner up selection was emphasized to be finalized in consultation with Chattarsal Stadium and colleges.
Action: AD (YA)
 - v. SOP for the event shall be shared for the activities i.e. Run, reel making, drama and quiz competition to all DPMs, DACOs, CDMOs and other concerned Colleges/Institution and schools. Beside contact details of RRCs shall be shared with DPM/DAPCU/CDMOs.
Action: AD(YA)

Drama

- i. It was decided that each district may finalized 1 team for the Drama from each district through a district level competition for state level competition. DPM concerned will co-ordinate these activities to be completed by 15th September 2023.

- ii. 5-10 minutes will be given to each team for drama competition, skit or nukkad natak or similar activity with awareness on HIV/AIDS at district level and at state level.
- iii. Funds for the activities shall be released timely to the DAPCUs.

- iv. CDMO/DACO may also identify the venue & judges for the activities at their district level.

- v. Awareness material may be made available to all RRC Colleges/institutes

Reel

- i. Reel making entries from districts will be collected through DPMs of their concerned districts. The entries shall be sent by each of the RRC nodal officer.
- ii. Reel should be 30 second to 1 minute for reel making it should be brief and precise with message on HIV/AIDS.
- iii. 03 best entries selected from each districts will be forwarded to DSACS.
- iv. The reels will be judged on innovation, creativity, content, animation, correct information in appropriate language etc.
- v. The submitted reels will also be used on our social media handles and open to likes.

School quiz competition


