7. Logo of Red Ribbon on Plants.

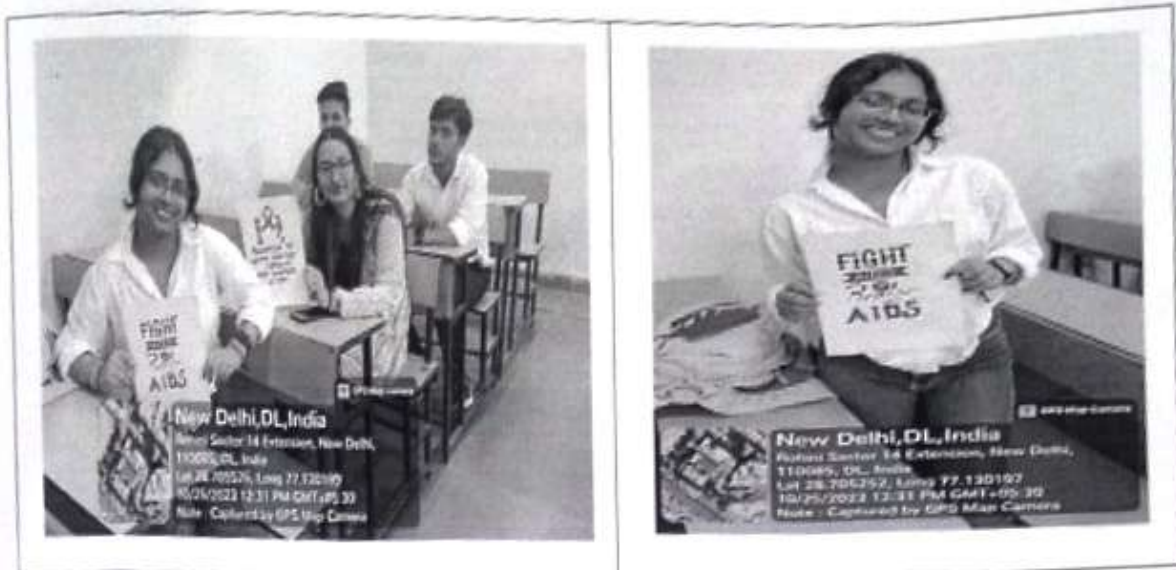
### EVENT 1: -

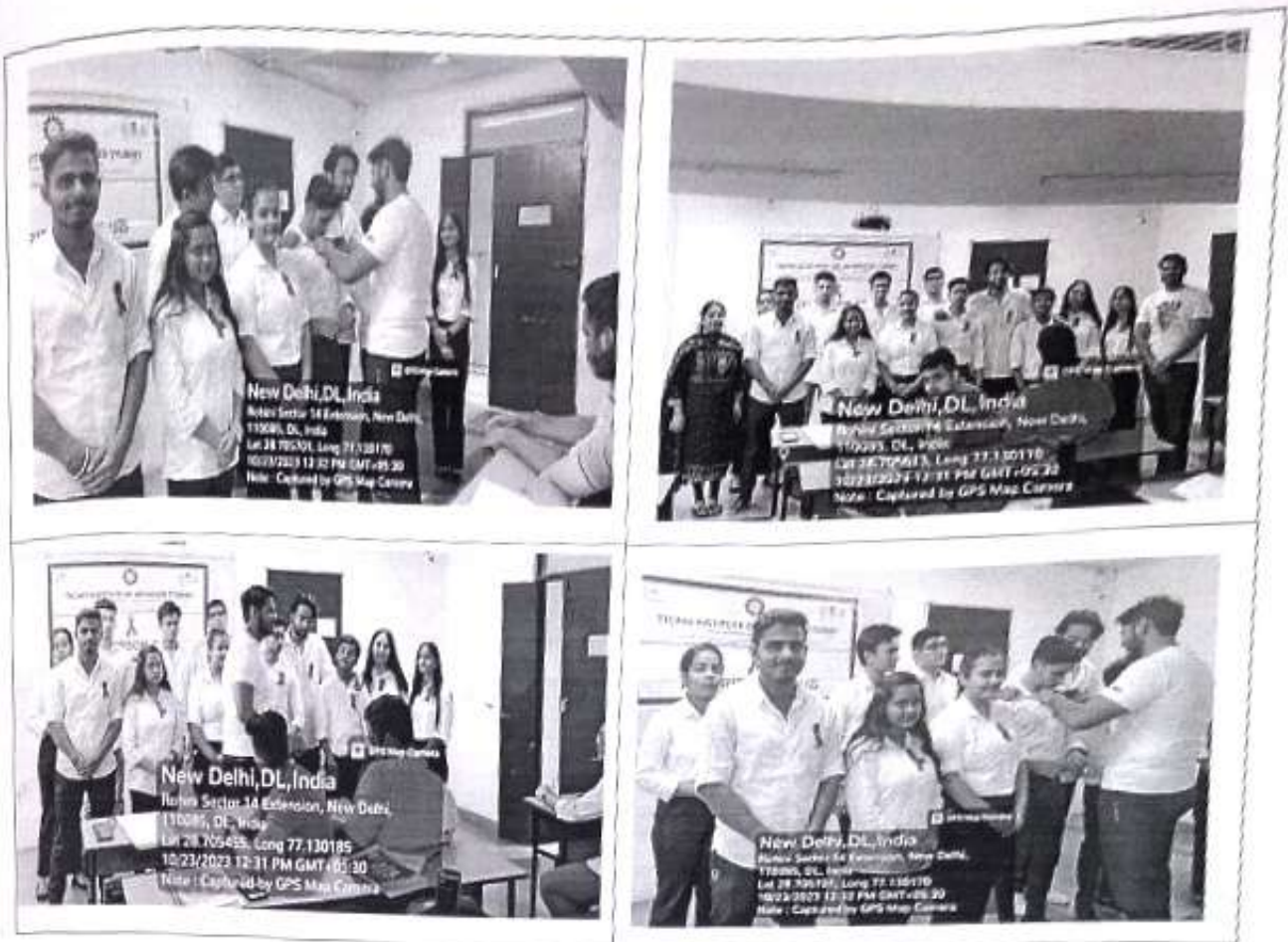
